ABSTRACT

Equality between women and men is one of the EU's founding values. Gender equality in Research and Innovation (R&I) has been a priority for the European Commission since the European Research Area Communication launch in 2012. Every three years, DG Research and Innovation publishes a report, the She Figures, which uses the latest available statistics to monitor the state of gender equality in R&I across Europe and beyond. This presentation will focus on the Research part and present recent data following the 'chronological journey' of women from graduating from tertiary education to participating in the labour market and acquiring decision-making roles.
