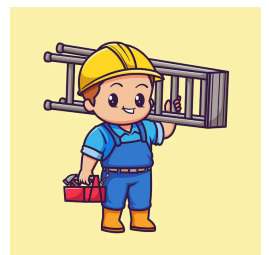
Backpacks: Please put backpacks in your locker instead of on the floor or on benches. Backpacks that are left out will be taken to the office. Let's keep HLV looking nice!
