



A scouts uniform is something that makes them feel like they are part of the group. When worn out in public it gives the scout a sense of pride when they are recognized as a scout.

The classic button up shirt everyone instantly recognizes is called the Class A uniform.

It is worn for parades, meetings and a few other events.

Pack 258 requires the Class A shirt with the neckerchief and slide that coordinates with the scouts current rank.

All Class A's will need a Westmoreland/Fayette council patch, a world crest patch and the number 258.

Webelos' and AOL's wearing the tan shirts will also need blue epaulets.

Any other parts of the uniform are optional (such as the pants, belt or hat).

LION SCOUTS

The Lion scouts Class A uniform is not the traditional button up.

They wear a blue tshirt with a lion on it.
