There is no page limit for inclusion in the Symposium Pro-ceedings. All papers will be printed in full. HOWEVER, in order to minimize the number of pages and achieve uniform appearance, it is required that the following format directions be adhered to strictly.

- 1 Introduction
- 1.1 Subsection 1
- 1.1.1 Subsubsection 1

Format for papers

Two options are available for paper submission:

- in electronic form, through e-mail. The paper should be in PDF format (preferable) or in a postscript file. Make sure that all illustrations are included in the file. Please do not use color graphs, as those will print poorly on black and white. Word document files will NOT be accepted.
- 2) camera-ready, in double-column format, on standard A4 or $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 inch paper.

All papers should be in two-column format, left and right justi-fied, with a column height of 24 cm (9 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches), column width of 9 cm (3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches), and distance between columns 0.5 cm ($\frac{1}{4}$ inch). A font size of 10 pt is required. Suggested fonts are times-roman or equivalent.

Title should be centered across the two columns, in 16 pt bold, upper and lower case letters. Author names should be in 12 pt font, while affiliation and any other information in the same (10 pt) font as the text of the paper. Above the title in a single line running across the two columns insert the symposium title date: "Bulk Power System Dynamics and Control VI, August 22-27, 2004, Cortina D'Ampezzo, Italy".

Please DO NOT leave a 2 inch empty space at the end of the first column!

Page number is required **in pencil** only in case an hard copy of paper is sent by mail.

Use double spacing between paragraphs, before headings, and after a major heading or a subheading. No indentation is neces-sary in paragraphs.

Major headings should be **bold**, subheadings in *italics*, sub-subheadings in *italics* and embedded in the first line of the fol-lowing paragraph, followed by a period and two spaces.

Note. If bold and italic type are not available please use UPPER CASE for major headings, lower case for subheadings, and <u>lower case underlined</u> for sub-subheadings respectively.
