### Core Course Selection:

All core courses are year-long. Students in the 6th grade are required to take the following core classes: English, Math, Science, History, along with Writing (year-long), Intro to Tech (semester), PE or equivalent (semester), and Fine Arts (2 semesters or a year-long course).
