

Google Classroom Mobile App

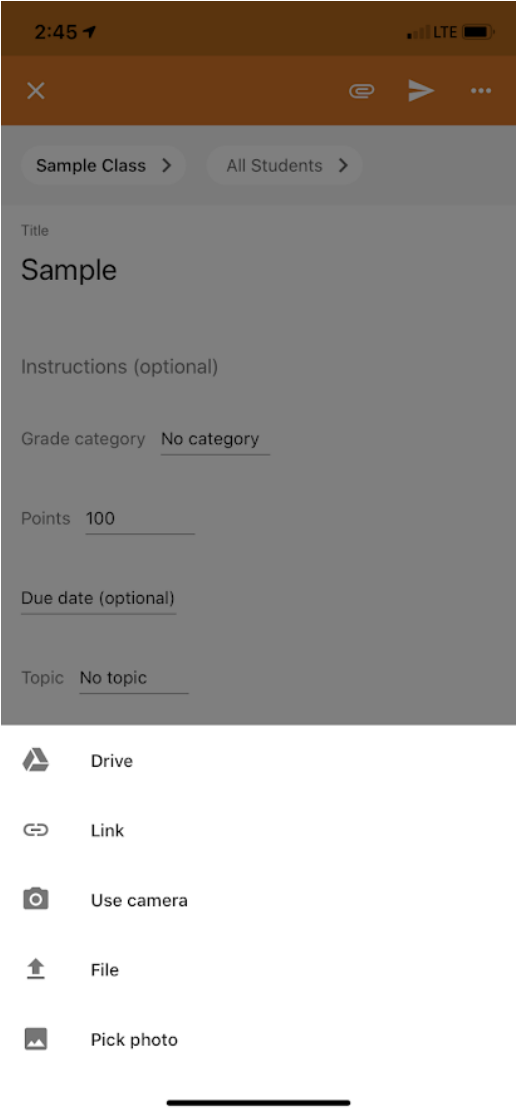
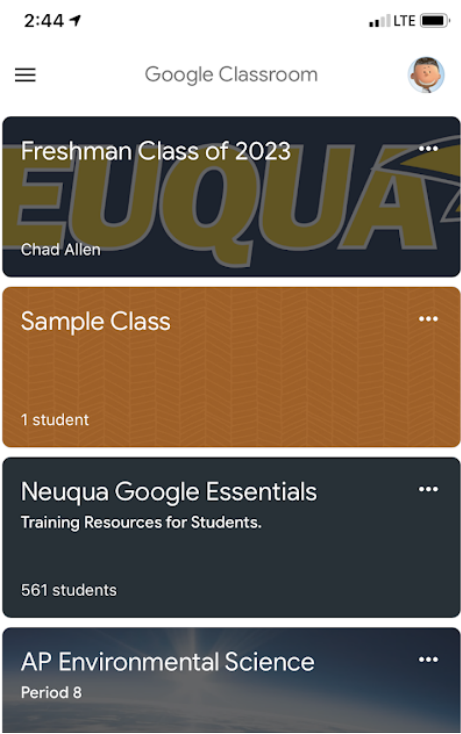
Sometimes teachers and students need to share something digitally that might not be digital. The Google Classroom Mobile App is a great tool to share both digital and non-digital items

Just about any file saved on your phone can be uploaded to Google Classroom using the Classroom Mobile App.

- Take a picture and share it with students.
- Record a short video introduction to a topic or assignment.
- Upload a voice memo.
- Upload a file from your device.
- Share to Classroom from other mobile apps.

Posting Using the App

The Google Classroom App allows you to share announcements, create assignments, add materials, or ask questions. When creating the app allows you to attach files from Drive, share a link, use your device camera to take a photo, use your device camera to record a video, attach a file, or add a file already saved on your device.

Sharing Directly from a File or App

If you have the Classroom App installed you can share directly to Google Classroom from most files or apps. Click on the share button and find the Classroom Icon to share.
