SUBJECT: Election Results for AY2022-23

The following are the results for openings on elected standing committees for the 2022-23 academic year. Again our committee chose to conduct the election using the software ElectionBuddy. Invitations to vote with secure links to the ballot were sent to the campus email addresses of faculty and professional staff as per the bylaws. Our committee sent 153 ballots to the faculty. We received 89 valid ballots, of which 64 ballots were from SAS, 11 were from SOB, 8 were from SOE, and 6 were from the Library. As per faculty bylaws, candidates needed 25% of the total votes cast to be elected (i.e. 22) for all committees except for the school specific committees (ARPT; Faculty Judicial, Faculty Rights and Responsibilities; and Faculty Senator-at-Large), who needed 25% of the school specific votes cast (SAS=16; SOB=3; SOE=2).

Our committee also sent 411 secure links to ballots to the professional staff to vote for University Faculty Senator and Senator Alternate as per the SUNY University Faculty Senate Bylaws and Procedures to campus email addresses. We received 38 valid ballots.

As per the bylaws, school specific positions on ARPT, Faculty Judicial, FRRC and Faculty Senator-at-Large were elected by faculty from the respective schools they will represent. Using ElectionBuddy we were able to create school specific ballots. However, At-Large candidates for these committees do not have to be from a particular school and received votes from any school.

There were ties for vacancies on the ARPT committee, ASCBD, and FJC (all candidates were elected with the required 25% of votes cast). On 4/27/2022, the ties were broken by three coin-tosses and Elena Smirnova, Linval Frazer, and Erik Benau won the tie-breaks, respectfully.

The FJC had no At-Large nominees. They will be filled by the runners-up from SAS.

The Faculty Senate Chair must still appoint faculty to the LEC Foreign Languages domain for a three-year term And the Social Sciences domain for a two-year term due to a resignation. The Chair must also appoint the SUNY Faculty Senator Alternate.
