BFG Co-Teacher: Student Ministry Guys, 9/10th Grade Guys

- ☐ Description: help lead/teach a BFG (Bible Fellowship Group) on Sunday mornings for 9th/10th grade guys. This BFG leader will partner with two other men to teach God's Word and intentionally build relationships with 9th–10th grade guys, helping them grow in their faith. The goal is to encourage these students to know Jesus personally and to live out their faith in everyday life.

By greeting families, answering questions, and helping parents and kids find their rooms, this role will help provide a friendly, welcoming presence that helps families feel known, comfortable, and excited to be here.

Preschool BFG Teacher

- ☐ Description: serve with at least one other adult in BFG for preschoolers. Includes sharing bible stories, doing crafts, and lots of fun and play.
- ☐ Weekly or bi-weekly
- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Curriculum and supplies are provided
- ☐ Background check is required
- ☐ Ages 18 and up

Bus Ministry Driver

- ☐ Contact: Jimmy Smith jimmy.smith@fbcallen.org
- ☐ Description: Driving our 14-passenger people mover on a scheduled route. Volunteers pick up senior adults and two adults from our Special Friends class before the service and return them home after church.
- ☐ Rotation: once every four weeks
- ☐ Training is provided and includes riding along with an experienced driver to become familiar with the route and the process of safely picking up and dropping off our church members.
- ☐ Current drivers license required (CDL is not necessary). Background and Driving Record check is required
- ☐ Ages 21 and up

Bus Ministry Assistant

- ☐ Description: Help create a welcoming and supportive environment by assisting church members as they get on and off the bus. Be a friendly presence, offer a helping hand, and provide encouragement to our senior adults and Special Friends as they attend worship each week.
- ☐ Rotation: once every four weeks
- ☐ Training is provided and includes riding along to become familiar with riders and the process of picking up and dropping off at church
- ☐ Background Check is required
- ☐ Ages 18 and up (can be a family ministry as well as long as there is room on the bus...children must be accompanied by a parent)

Preschool "Tag Team"

- ☐ Description: accepting and releasing preschoolers from parents. Serve with at least one other adult in the preschool ministry at the 10:30 am hour. Includes playing with

preschoolers, sharing the provided Bible story, using prepared crafts, and taking preschoolers to the playroom or playground (following the schedule provided).

- ☐ Rotation: varies...most rotations are 4-8 weeks. (You may serve more often if you choose.)
- ☐ Training is provided

First Impressions Team

- ☐ Description: Our First Impressions Team are smiling faces in parking lots and the doors all around campus greeting people, helping people to feel welcome, and assisting people to find their way around campus.
- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Background check is required
- ☐ This is open for all ages. Elementary age kids and younger must serve with a parent

Baptism Team

- ☐ Description: Responsibilities include warmly greeting those being baptized, guiding them to the dressing rooms, ensuring they have a baptism t-shirt, helping them get lined up and ready. Your presence helps make the experience smooth, personal, and memorable.

- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Background check is required
- ☐ Ages 21 and up

Children's Ministry Special Friends BFG Teacher

- ☐ Description: serve with at least one other adult weekly in BFG for elementary age children with special needs. Includes play, bible story, helping with snack time
- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Curriculum and materials are provided
- ☐ Background Check is required
- ☐ Rotation: once a month
- ☐ Ages 18 and up

Children's Ministry Wednesday Night Leader

- ☐ Contact: Lezah Maitland lezah.maitland@fbcallen.org

- ☐ Description: serve alongside another adult as you teach children about mission locally and around the world. This includes bible stories, stories about missionaries, crafts/activities, and fun with the children
- ☐ Areas of highest need: One children's Special Friends Teacher and one Welcome Desk Greeter
- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Curriculum and materials are provided
- ☐ Background Check is required
- ☐ Rotation: weekly
- ☐ Ages 18 and up

Security and Medical Team

- ☐ Contact: Rodger Teaff rodger.teaff@fbcallen.org
- ☐ Description: Help ensure a safe and welcoming environment at FBC Allen. Volunteers assist with basic safety duties, communicate with on-site police officers, and respond to emergencies by alerting appropriate authorities and church staff.
- ☐ Training is provided.
- ☐ Background Check is required
- ☐ For medical team, basic knowledge of first aid and CPR is preferred
- ☐ Rotation: monthly or as often as you would like to serve
- ☐ Ages: 21 and up

DivorceCare Facilitator (2 needed)

- ☐ Contact: Jimmy Smith jimmy.smith@fbcallen.org
- ☐ Description: lead a small group of adults (who are going through or have gone through divorce) through a video-based curriculum that addresses different issues related to divorce. You will act as a facilitator for the group asking discussion questions and providing encouragement. You do not have to have gone through a divorce in order to lead.
- ☐ An interview with Jimmy Smith is required to prayerfully consider whether this is the right fit for you and for our DivorceCare ministry.
- ☐ Training is provided
- ☐ Background Check is required
- ☐ DivorceCare Group is a 13 week commitment
- ☐ Workbooks and Videos provided
- ☐ Ages: 30 and up

ESL Volunteer

- ☐ Description: Assist alongside other leaders in teaching adults basic English conversation and writing skills. Volunteers help create a welcoming environment, support learners

during class activities, and encourage them as they grow in confidence using the English language.
