This session will be delivered by Paddy Bowen, former President of Volunteer Canada, and leader of numerous charities and voluntary sector projects (and current Executive Director of MAS). Anecdotal evidence indicates

that many volunteers put on pause during the pandemic, never came back. And as baby boomers fully retire, including from volunteer work, a void is being felt by many not-for-profits. New approaches to how volunteer programs are designed and managed can help address these trends. This session will be good for Executive Directors and/or the person in your organization responsible to recruit and manage volunteers.
