

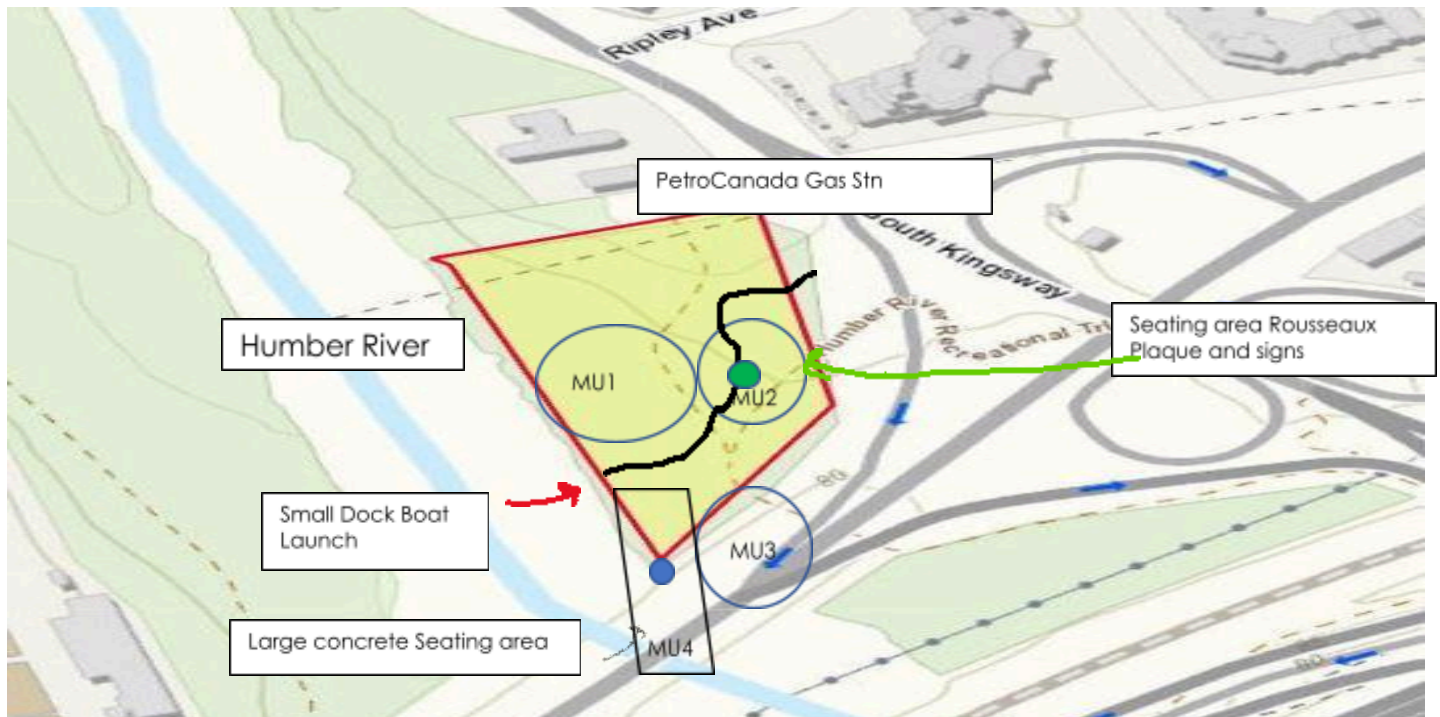
Site Assessment

Site:	South Humber River /South Kingsway

South Humber River/ South Kingsway is located at approximately 8 South Kingsway. The site is on the east side of the Humber River and South of the Petro Canada Gas Station and Carwash. The site extends to the Westbound on ramp to The Queensway. A small parking lot at the north end of the site, a driveway down to the river and boat launch with some parking spots available on the roadway. Two paved bike paths go through the site connecting to the Waterfront Trail. The site has a small boat launch and small dock into the Humber River. The area contains two small seating areas, one with a plaque describing Jean-Baptiste Rousseaux and four interpretive signs about the Rousseaux Family and early Toronto, describing Portage de Toronto or Carrying Place Toronto.

Stewardship Site Location map: Features and Management Units

The site is mainly hardwood forest with mature trees along both the Humber River and South Kingsway. Recent bridge repairs and post construction ground repairs have added about 30 new native trees planted along the southern area and walking/bike path.
