V. Development Committee Update

- Anders Peterson previewed a Development update to the board.
- It was highlighted that there is a \$200K funding gap at this period due to a foundation not renewing this year. The goal is to fill in the gap with another prospect and innovative fundraising efforts.
- An ask was proposed to the board on helping Development make new prospect connections to help close the gap. He has a list of old and new prospects.
- He also previewed the following upcoming events:
 - Alumni Career Networking event on January 11.
 - The Toast on April 5 Theme: 20 years of the Phoenix.

VI. Executive Director Update

- Meekerley Sanon presented and shared on current school updates. Previewed at the onset, the framework for the strategic plan.
- She provided an overview to illustrate three pillars of the strategic plan: Rigorous Academics, Persistence, and Ethical Development, with five underpinnings: Finance and Development, Human Capital, Operations, Family Engagement, Enriching Experiences.
- Enriching Experiences proposed as a 4th Pillar.
- Each pillar is directly connected to the vision.
- It was recommended to view other schools' strategic plans for comparison.
- The Portrait of the Graduate remains part of the vision of the school.
- Leadership continues to craft the strategic plan which will turn into an actionable plan.
- Stakeholder input will be surveyed from staff, students, families, and alumni to integrate and align with different voices and perspectives for the new roadmap for Boston Prep.
- Academic Rob Rametti previewed a plan for academic acceleration.
- Curriculum, leadership, instruction, and assessment.
- Meekerley previewed a plan for future data dashboards and review. Open Architects is
 the new data platform that will offer a central portal for the disaggregated data to be
 reviewed at each board meeting.
- A preview and rollout will occur at the board retreat. The board will be issued a login and access to the dashboard.
