1. INTRODUCTION

(Left, Bold, Times New Roman 13, UPPER CASE, Before 18 pt, After 6pt)

Articles are made into 1 column pages with A4 paper size. For Top Margin 3 cm, Left Margin 2.5 cm, Bottom Margin 1.5 cm, and Right Margin 1.5 cm. Manuscripts are made using Microsoft Word, single spaced, 10 pt Times New Roman, and no more than 10-15 pages.

Please choose an article title with a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 14 words needed to adequately describe the content. The introduction must describe the background of the research, research problems, at least 4 similar/related research studies (updated 5 years before) by raising differences in research, the purpose and urgency of why research should be carried out, the solutions offered to the problems encountered so as to bring out the state of the art of your research. The introduction must also include a statement of the contribution of the research results. In research articles, it is mandatory to have references/citations, reference models (Kusrini, 2007) and so on. It is MANDATORY to use the **Mendeley/Endnote/Zotero citation tool** in the **American Psychological Association 7 th Edition format** (with a minimum number of **20 references and up to date 5 years before**). Terms in foreign languages are written in italics.

It is recommended for authors to use the following article structure: **INTRODUCTION (min 800 words)** – **RESEARCH METHODS (min 700 words)** – **RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (min 1900 words)** – **CONCLUSION (min 200 words)**. The maximum article **contains 10–15 pages**, if the article goes beyond 15 pages after the editing stage, a charge per page will be charged.

2. RESEARCH METHODS

2.1 Research Procedures and Framework

The research procedure provides a detailed description of the procedure followed in completing the experiment discussed in the study. This section also describes Materials and Methods which is well written as a set of instructions for anyone wishing to replicate research in the future. It can also explain briefly about the research location, research hypotheses and variables, as well as the study of the techniques/analytical/testing methods used in the research. In this section there is also an overview and explanation of the research framework in conducting research. These components (MANDATORY IN THE ARTICLE).

It is better if there are figures and tables, it must be presented with the names of tables and figures accompanied by serial numbers as shown in Figure 1 and Table 1.

For LOGO, use high quality for the image used and include the image number in the description of the image. Image numbering must be linked/included in the image description. The formula uses the Formula Editor found in

Microsoft Word. Formula numbering is made sequentially based on the order of the formulas contained in the article, and the writing is like (1).

In the contents of the manuscript, for writing citations/references (Kusrini, 2007) and so on, it is MANDATORY to use the **Mendeley/Endnote/Zotero** citation tool in the **American Psychological Association 7 th Edition format** (with a minimum number of 20 references and up to date 5 years before). 3. RESULT AND DISCUSSION

This section describes the results of the study. Results should be presented clearly and concisely. Authors should explore the novelty or contribution of the research to the literature used. Present clearly the results of testing, analysis and discussion using primary, relevant and up-to-date references.

Figures and Tables must be placed as close as possible to their reference points in the text and must be numbered sequentially as they appear in the text. **All Figures and Tables must have a title (minimum 2 words) and must be referred to from within the description of the tables and figures.** In this case it must be added and numbered sequentially in decimal numbers with descriptive information. **Avoid colorful images.** This section also represents explanations in the form of explanations, pictures, tables and others. The number of words in this section is around **1800 words min.**

3.1 Discussion

Must have a discussion section that explains the discussion of the research results in relation to the hypotheses taken in the research. The discussion sub-section also compares with studies from similar research results used in the introductory section. References are also mandatory in this section.

4. CONCLUSION

The conclusion section contains the final results of the research, the limitations of the research and possible improvements in further research. The conclusion also contains answers to all the problems contained in the research. The contents of the conclusion **may not be in the form of points, but in the form of paragraphs (1 paragraph).** The number of words in this section is around **200 words min.**

All references cited in this article are MANDATORY IN THE ARTICLE CONTENTS and it is MANDATORY to use the Mendeley/Endnote/Zotero reference tool in APA Style 7th Edition format, 80% PRIMARY literature (journals, proceedings, research reports, patents, standards, historical documents, research books at least 5 years prior) and 20% SECONDARY literature (books, reliable websites) within the last 8 years.

The minimum number of references used is 20 references.
