# Boys Basketball and Cheerleading:

As a reminder, athletic eligibility will start on Monday, November 3rd with the first eligibility report being run on Friday, October 31st. Eligibility is determined per the Athletic Handbook as follows:

### Athletic and ExtraCurricular Eligibility

A student's first responsibility is to his or her schoolwork and grades. It is believed that students who do not achieve in accordance with their abilities do not have time to participate in extracurricular activities or sports. It is further believed that students who display a negative attitude, poor conduct, or less than full effort should not be representing the school in extracurricular activities. Therefore, participating in sports or extracurricular activities will be allowed only as long as grade, attitude, conduct, and effort warrant it.

Grades, Attitude, Conduct and Effort – To determine a player's eligibility status, teachers will evaluate students on a weekly basis. Their academic status will be based upon a weekly eligibility progress report. An academic grade average of less than a "C-", two "D's", or any failing grades indicates that additional effort is needed and does not warrant participation in extracurricular activities. THE LOWEST PERCENT FOR A "C-" IS A 70. Each athletic season lasts approximately 6-8 weeks, and students who are chronically ineligible (3 weeks or more-approximately ½ of the season) may be removed from the team.

Ineligibility for participation in games will be monitored on a weekly basis. The eligibility grade is determined by what grade a student-athlete is receiving on each Friday. The reporting period will begin the next Monday at 7:45 a.m. and will continue to 7:45 a.m. the next Monday. Special circumstances may be appealed to the athletic director.

- 1. A student-athlete is ineligible for one FULL week (from Monday to Monday), and may resume participating in games if they raise their grades to eligibility status by the next Friday. Eligibility would resume.
- 2. A student-athlete may still participate in practices during their ineligibility. If they are ineligible for more than one week, a player and coach may determine it is in the student-athlete's best interest to miss practice as well to become eligible.
- 3. If the ineligibility becomes chronic, a student-athlete may be removed from the team to focus on academics.






# McHenry Middle School 2 Mile Cross Country Course







# **Sports Physical:**

Schedule your sports physical today. Per IESA By-Laws, no student shall be permitted to to compete in a tryout, practice, or contest, unless such student has filed with the school principal a certificate of physical fitness issued by a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or nurse practitioner as set forth in the Illinois State Statutes not more than 395 days preceding such tryout, practice, or contest in any athletic activity. Please make note of tryout dates listed below for all sports to ensure a physical is on file prior to that date. Sports Physical Form
