- Call or visit any of the Housing Resource Centers listed in this directory




Find Your Local Housing Resource Center

Gender Based Violence Survivors

Alameda County recently launched a new service for survivors of gender-based violence (GBV) who are facing the prospect of homelessness. GBV survivors who are actively fleeing, have fled and are experiencing homelessness, or who are seeking to flee violence and are at high-risk of falling into homelessness can now access Coordinated Entry services at dedicated Access Points operated by victim service providers.
