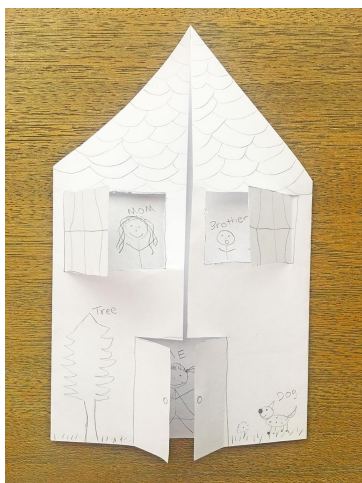


Paper house. Draw pictures of family.

Finger Leg Puppets

- Cardboard (cut an empty cereal box)
- Scissors
- Pencils or markers

Draw a character – a person, an animal, a monster, an alien. Make sure to leave space at the bottom for the legs!

Once you are done drawing, cut two round holes at the bottom of your character so you can slip your fingers into them to make legs.

Paper Dog Puppet



- Square paper
- Pen

Pull on the corners of the ears, to make the dog “talk”.

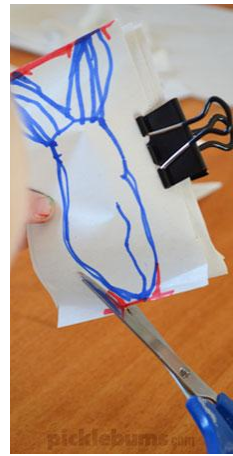
Paper Chains



- Strips of paper
- Scissors
- Markers or pencils
- A paper clip or

binder clip to hold the layers together while kids cut.

Fold paper concertina style, then clip the paper together to make it easier to keep together while drawing and cutting.



Draw marks on the paper at each side to show kids where their drawings need to touch the edge so the chains are connected.

Draw design, making sure some part of it is touching each side of the paper. Cut around the design, make sure you don't cut the edges that need to stay connected. Unfold your chain.
