I am extremely excited to talk to y'all here today about the biggest Civil Rights abuse and issue facing our nation today. And that is the key and politically charged issue of Abortion. And more broadly, how our Constitutional Right to Life and natural right to life interact with a society that condones such practices as abortion. First we have to understand what abortion is. And that's a rather simple thing. From a scientific viewpoint, abortion is uncategorically murder from the moment of conception. Using any measure of biology and science you can to define life, you will find that from the moment of conception, human life is present. So we are then presented with this question of, what kind of society are we where we deny this basic and most fundamental of human and indeed American rights to living human beings just because of where they are located or how small

and non-developed they are? That is a society which is fundamentally morally broken. And that is not what America is. America is based on a culture of life. You look to our founding, we stood up against the British when they callously spilled our blood in the Boston Massacre, we stood for our inalienable rights, among these life, liberty, and property. The first of those is life! Life is the right most inextricable from the human condition because without that basic right to live, there is no point to exercise any others as your own life and personage is no longer in your possession. That's absolutely absurd. But we are presented with the question, doesn't Pro-Life legislation harm women's rights? The fact is that there is no right to abortion and that that is a relic of a time when substantive due process not only reigned on the court but it allowed us to overlook even what little we knew of the now indomitable knowledge of fetal personhood. We now understand that abortion ends the life of a human being who fulfills all 7 parameters of life.

This is why I believe it is so important we elect Pro-Life majorities into Congress and elect a Pro-Life President. The only way that we are going to restore full and equal protection under law of all peoples is by passing the Human Life Amendment which would spell it out in our Constitution that the right to life does indeed apply to the unborn. This is such a no-brainer that it is a shame that we even have to put it in there, but we do. And when we do, and only then, will we have guaranteed full and equal constitutional protections to all peoples and demographic groups in this nation. Our duty as a nation is to each other and to our principles. Our principle of Liberty cannot be overridden on this issue, we will not allow the Right to Life to be destroyed and forgotten any longer, castigated by a society disinterested in its intrinsic value to the human condition. It's time we took a stand for our values and for the values that make this nation great and moral. As

President I will lead the fight to once and for all recognize the unborn as people, equal and just as valid as your or I and deserving of full protection against those that would do them harm. But I can only do this through you, it will take a real mandate to show the world that we do not play around when it comes to Equality, we believe it goes all the way around and reaches all men, who are created equal.

I will leave you with this, PLEASE, donate to whichever adoption center, CPC, or Pro-Life clinic is nearest to you and support this Convention in whichever way you can. This is the grassroots moving helping women through the difficult time of pregnancy, and helping her choose life. This is the movement for Equality and Justice. We are the movement that will finally complete the journey of Dixie's own Dr. King that we will finally know that injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere.
