

Update on School Closure 3-20-20

Dear District 128 Families,

We received an update from Governor Pritzker during his Press Conference this afternoon that schools will remain closed through Tuesday, April 7, 2020. He has issued a Shelter in Place order for all people in the state of Illinois beginning tomorrow. A Shelter in Place order should not significantly change how you are currently operating, if you have already been practicing social distancing. A Shelter in Place means that you can still leave your home for essential needs (groceries, bank, pharmacy, health care, food delivery will be maintained from restaurants, etc.). You can go outdoors to walk your dogs, get exercise and fresh air, but when outdoors you should exercise social distancing.

Our staff has done a phenomenal job of supporting our students. We anticipated and are prepared for the extended closure. We had worked on the development of E-Learning plans to support our students March 31 - April 3. We will be able to continue working to be prepared for April 6 and 7. We are keeping our <u>E-Learning page</u> updated throughout this unexpected closure. Our teachers will continue to communicate the plans as they unfold when we return from Spring Break week on March 30, 2020.

We recognize that the tentative return date of April 8, 2020 is just that, tentative. As we learn more from the Illinois State Board of Education, we will communicate more details regarding the extended E-Learning plan. We know our Independence students have their devices at home and teachers will continue to develop work and communicate it through their Google classrooms. For K-5, we are working on a plan to deploy iPads to families who do not have access to devices at home. The details related to the deployment will be sent out early next week. When that communication is sent out next week, we will need families to confirm they would like us to deliver the device and to electronically sign off on a user agreement to do so. Please remember, that our designated spring break begins on Monday, so students will have next week off to spend quality time with families. I have attached some outdoor activities you can consider doing with your families over the course of next week.
