

SBO SKIT VIDEO RULES AND GUIDELINES

The following guidelines must be met to perform an SBO skit video:

- ✓ Inappropriate themes, behavior, dress, music, and speech are prohibited.
- ✓ Please be respectful of all different backgrounds and cultures.
- ✓ There will be no sexual innuendos allowed, language, etc.
- ✓ Skits must follow the school dress code. No shirts are to be torn off, fake stripping, swimsuits, etc.
- ✓ There will be no violation of the safe school policy. No threats, hazing, harassment, demeaning, or embarrassing situations.
- ✓ **Skit videos may not exceed 3 minutes.**
- ✓ You must speak for approximately 30-60 seconds after your video. You should explain the qualities you possess that make you an SBO candidate. DO NOT tell students that you will provide something for them that is beyond your realm of power (for example: “We will have 6 dances next year if I am elected, the food will taste better in the cafeteria, etc.).
- ✓ You must provide all of your costumes, props, music, etc.
- ✓ No faculty/staff from Snowcrest can be in your skit.
- ✓ If your video is not to Mr. Anderson by the due date specified, you may not show a video and will only have a picture, just like all the other candidates.
- ✓ Before your video is played, there will be a slide introducing you. So, please send me a **digital picture of you and also a short bio of yourself**. This will be displayed before students watch your video. Please email the picture & bio to maanderson1@wsd.net
- ✓ Please upload your video to Google Drive and share it with Mr. Anderson as an **EDITOR**.
