

## Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) Guidance on Critical vs. Non-Critical Business Professions

Please consult the following lists for guidance concerning the "critical" versus "non-critical" designations of DORA-regulated professions and services in light of the COVID-19 crisis. Once you have located your professional license type, we encourage you to read any associated Executive or State-Issued Public Health Orders for further direction, and to be aware of the mended and extended Statewide "Stay-at-Home" Order issued by Governor Jared Polis, effective April 6 through April 26, 2020, as well as any county or city specific health or "stay-at-home" orders. Other COVID-related communications and notifications, separated by profession, can be found on DORA's website.

"Critical Professions" Under DORA's Purview (Note: The following professions must still adhere to the mandates in <a href="Executive Order D 2020 027">Executive Order D 2020 027</a> prohibiting elective, non-emergency procedures\*\*, as well as the social distancing requirements in <a href="Amended Public Health Order 20-24">Amended Public Health Order 20-24</a>, and apply <a href="telehealth practices">telehealth practices</a> as recommended by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) where possible):

NEW: Executive Order D 2020 027, issued April 6, 2020, has extended the temporary cessation of all elective and non-essential surgeries and procedures prohibition through at least April 26, 2020. These measures were previously enacted by Executive Order D 2020 009.

- Massage Therapy (ONLY if providing services through a medical office or practice and if adhering to Executive Order D 2020 027 prohibiting elective procedures)

- Naturopathic Doctor (ONLY if adhering to Executive Order D 2020 027 prohibiting elective procedures)
- Nursing
- Nursing Home Administrator
- Occupational Therapy (ONLY if adhering to Executive Order D 2020 027 prohibiting elective procedures)
- Optometry (ONLY if adhering to Executive Order D 2020 027 prohibiting elective procedures)

- Physical Therapy (ONLY if adhering to Executive Order D 2020 027 prohibiting elective procedures)

\*\*Note: Rural and critical access hospitals are exempt from this Order, but are strongly advised to comply on a voluntary basis. Rural and critical access hospitals are, however, directed to comply with CDC guidelines for PPE preservation. Please refer directly to the order for further clarification in this area.

Non-Critical Personal Services Professions (Must adhere to the mandates in <u>Public</u> <u>Health Order 20-22</u> regarding cessation of business activity, whether operating out of a business or a home):
