



METRO RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Troop 1A: All members assigned to the **Golden office of Troop 1A** shall reside within 30 road miles of Jefferson County or anywhere within Clear Creek County.

Troop 1C: All members assigned to the **Castle Rock office of Troop 1C** shall reside within 30 road miles of the troop boundary.

Troop 1D: All members assigned to the **Adams County Office of Troop 1D** shall reside within 30 road miles of their formally assigned duty station. (North Boundary Line -168th Avenue, East Boundary Line-Zuni, South Boundary Line-52nd Avenue, East Boundary Line-Hayesmount Road)

All members assigned to the **Boulder office of Troop 1D** shall reside within 30 road miles of their formally assigned duty station.

Troop 3A: All uniformed members assigned to the **Greeley Office** will reside within the geographic boundaries of Troop 3A and within 50 road miles from the Greeley State Patrol Office (10601 W. 10th St., Greeley) or

- o If not within the geographic boundaries of Troop 3A, then within 30 road miles from the Greeley State Patrol Office and no further west than the intersection of U.S. Highway 34 and Glade Road or
- o If not within the geographic boundaries of Troop 3A, then within 30 road miles from the Platteville Police Department (400 Grand Ave, Platteville) and no further west than the eastern junction of Colorado Highway 66 and U.S. Highway 36.

Troop 3C: All other uniformed members assigned to the **Fort Collins Office** will reside within the geographic boundaries of Troop 3C, and within 50 road miles from the Fort Collins State Patrol Office (3832 S. I-25, Fort Collins); or if not within the geographic boundaries of Troop 3C, then within 25 road miles from the Fort Collins State Patrol Office.
