

<p>What is the difference between a vertebrate and invertebrate animal?</p> <p>The vertebrate has backbone and the invertebrate doesn't</p>	<p>What are the main 5 groups of vertebrate animals?</p> <p>Mammals, fish, amphibians, reptiles and birds</p>	<p>Name the main features of mammals</p> <p>Most live on land, they have fur, they have 4 limbs, mothers feed their child with their milk, they are viviparous, they breathe through lungs; they have hot blood.</p>
<p>Name the main features of birds</p> <p>They live on land and can fly; they have feathers, beak, 2 legs and 2 wings, they have scales; they breathe through gills; they are oviparous, they have hot blood.</p>	<p>Name the main features of amphibians</p> <p>They live on land and under the water; they have bare moist skin; adults have lungs and young have gills; they have 4 legs; they live in humid places; they are oviparous; they have cold blood.</p>	<p>Name the main features of fish</p> <p>They live under the water and swim; they have scales; they breathe through gills; they have fins; they have tails to swim; they are oviparous; they have cold blood.</p>
<p>Name the main features of reptiles</p> <p>Most live on land, some can swim; all breathe through lungs; they have scales; they are oviparous; they have cold blood; they live in warm places; most have 4 legs, but some have no legs.</p>	<p>Name 5 mammals</p> <p>Rabbit, monkey, kangaroo, cat, dog, elephant, whale...</p>	<p>Name 5 birds</p> <p>Eagle, dove, penguin, ostrich, parrot, vulture, swallow...</p>
<p>Name 4 amphibians</p> <p>Frog, toad, salamander, newt</p>	<p>Name 5 reptiles</p> <p>Crocodile, iguana, turtle, snake, lizard, komodo dragon, molok...</p>	<p>Name 5 fish</p> <p>White shark, hammerhead shark, sardine, seahorse, salmon, stingray, roosterfish, trout...</p>
<p>What kind of animal is the HEN and why?</p> <p>It is a bird, because it has feathers, wings, and beak; it has lungs; it is oviparous; it breathes through lungs; it has hot blood.</p>	<p>What kind of animal is a DOLPHIN and why?</p> <p>It is a mammal because it is viviparous, its baby develops in its mother's uterus and is fed by milk; it has 4 limbs; it breathes through lungs.</p>	<p>What kind of animal is the CHAMELEON and why?</p> <p>It is a reptile because it is oviparous; it has scales; it crawls; it breathes through lungs; it has cold blood.</p>
<p>What kind of animal is the TOAD and why?</p> <p>It is an amphibian because it is oviparous; it has bare moist skin; it has gills when it's young and lungs when it's adult; it has 4 legs and cold blood.</p>	<p>What kind of animal is the SEAHORSE and why?</p> <p>It is a fish because it lives under the sea and swims; it has scales and fins; it breathes through gills; it is oviparous.</p>
