Trial HSC Exam Timetable

Trial HSC Examinations are scheduled to commence on Monday the 17th August and finish on Friday 28th August. Please find important information about trials below.

- Students need to be assembled **30 minutes** before the English exam and **20 minutes before all other exams**. The exam centre shuts 60 minutes after the commencement of each examination and no acceptances after this time, for any reason, are allowed.
- Students must remain in the HSC Trial Examination room for the complete duration of any HSC Trial Examination.
- If students miss any Trial Examination(s), they must contact the Leader of Curriculum (Mrs Tovey) on the day of the exam and complete an Illness/Misadventure form, a copy of which can be found in the Office. All medical related misadventures must be supported with a medical certificate. All non illness related misadventures must have sufficient evidence to support their absence. Please note holidays/long weekends are not acceptable reasons. As the Trial Examinations are a part of the College's internal HSC Assessment, unsupported reasons for absence will result in a zero mark being awarded.
- The Trial Examinations will be held in the Edmund Rice Centre. **Students do not have to attend school** during Trial HSC Examinations when they are not completing an exam, however they are able to use the school facilities to work, study or complete major projects with permission and supervision from their respective course teachers.
- All students remaining on the College grounds outside of an examination period are to be actively learning. All students, without exception, must be in full school winter uniform (not sports uniform) for all examinations, and if attending school during this period.
- Students need to consult with their respective course teacher to determine the equipment needed for each exam. Students cannot borrow any equipment under exam conditions even if their equipment fails. Students are reminded that as with all HSC exams mobile phones, Smart watches and electronic communication devices are not permitted in an examination room under any circumstances.
