Scholarships – *Three unclaimed scholarships from 21-22. Four responses from Erich's email. Two formerly unclaimed have submitted for reimbursement. Talk about follow up on a regular basis with parents of scholarship winners. Select a person from scholarship committee to coordinate communications between parents/students. Will appoint a person from within the committee. 7/1 – 6/30, fiscal year. Must be TCAPS approved voice instructor. Directors have supplied the list to students. Suggestion to meet as a committee separately to work through the details. One student was over by \$115 amount. Erich agreed to pay difference from his discretionary account*

Uniforms – *most turned in and at the cleaners. Heather SL volunteered to help with uniforms along with Natalie. Tammy LaFaive volunteered to help at camp, as well as Kathy Stewart and Samantha Fewins.*

Spirit Wear – *Add items and promote for camp. Recmommend adding at least one lower price item (tshirt etc). Heather SL offered to price out from Bay Supply and underwrite half so all students have one shirt given at camp . Suggestion to have a smaller meeting regarding bulk purchase. Angela remarked about having proper sizes. Heather committed to underwrite half for the next 5 years. Stacy suggests adding water bottles to store. Store in Stacy's parents basement.*

- *Fundraising ideas to replace musical program ads and Golden Fowler raffle since musical is now in the fall. Tammy has a contact at Team Bob's. New sponsors for this year with the switch from spring to fall musical. Continue to brainstorm fundraising ideas to maintain scholarship fund. Something low cost like a sing a thon*
- *Turn off vending machines during performances and don't sell concessions at musical events. Money earned does not justify stocking and staffing (volunteers)*
- *Emerick – final concert on Tuesday. Has a long list for Madrigals, good problem to have. Givebutter donation has been rolled out, a couple of donations have come in. Would like to communicate donation feedback to audiences. \$5000 target. Wants more participation in CCC from parents. Will be October 22. May change date due to HS conflicts.*
