



How to Review Scores and Feedback for Graded Work

It may not be easy to find grades and comments on Lulima largely because of how that information is provided varies from instructor to instructor. However, here are the basics of how you can find the grade information of your graded work.

Discussion and Private Messages Tool

1. Go to the **Discussions and Private Messages** tool and click on the **View Topic Scores** or **View Forum Scores** link of the discussion you want to review:

Note: If you click on “View Topic Scores” you will need to click on an additional **View Scores** link for the discussion topic you wish to review.

Note: The availability of feedback and the type of feedback displayed will vary depending on the quiz settings specified by your instructor.

Assignments, Tests and Surveys

Depending upon the settings your instructor chose when creating the test, you may be able to see your test scores in the tools Assessments list Grade column and in the Gradebook. However, it’s possible that it is set up so the test scores don’t show anywhere until the instructor reviews the answers and grades the submissions. In that case, you will see ‘ungraded’ in the test list, and you will see a ‘ – ’ in the Gradebook. Or, the instructor can choose to never show grades in the Gradebook, if the test is not administered for a grade, and perhaps there won’t even be a Gradebook in your class. These options are all set by the instructor so they may vary from class to class.

The image shows the student side of “Assignments, Tests, & Surveys.” All assessments (new, in progress and completed) show up in one list. The columns provide much information: The Grade column shows total points earned and possibly a link to review of results:

- If feedback is set to ‘immediate,’ you will see the review page as soon as you submit the test. You can also click on the review link at a later date to view it again.
- If review is not available until a specific time, that date will be listed. The review link will become active at the specified time.
- If no feedback is available, no review link will be shown.

Notes:

- If the test is graded, the highest score/review is shown in the Grade column. If the test is ungraded, the Review page, if allowed, shows the latest try. In a future release, students will be able to review all tries.
- If the test allows multiple tries, the highest score is always used for grading.
