



Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

The Emergency Medical Technician Technical Diploma consists of EMS 100 EMR/EMT 1 and EMS 101 EMT2. There may be some difference in cost depending on whether the courses are taken concurrently in one semester or sequentially across semesters. These are indicated below.

National Registry Exam - Written <i>Paid directly to NREMT, students schedule exams directly with a Pearson Vue Testing Center. Payment for the written exam (via Debit or Credit card) is made directly within the NREMT website. Directions on how to enter this site will be provided by the Lead Instructor.</i> <i>Note: Once the NREMT receives the payment from this site, the student will receive a confirmation letter, again via the student's NREMT site, with a confirmation number. The student will then need to go to the Pearson Vue site (Vue.com) and apply for an EMT-Basic written exam, providing Pearson Vue with the confirmation number from the NREMT, which indicates that payment was made. The student then sets up a time (appointment) to take their written test.</i>	\$104.00
