Bible Study Questions

1. In Matthew 5:14-16, Jesus calls His followers the light of the world. What does this passage say about how our light should shine and why it matters?
2. Philippians 2:14-15 talks about how our attitude affects our witness. What does this passage say about how we should act in a world that doesn't always honor God?
3. Colossians 4:5-6 gives wisdom about how we interact with those around us. What does this passage say about the way we should speak and behave toward others?
4. In 1 Peter 3:15, we are told to be ready to give an answer about our faith. According to this verse, how should we respond when people ask us about our hope in Christ?
5. Romans 12:2 speaks about being transformed rather than conforming to the world. What does this passage say about how we should approach our work environment as Christians?

Reflection Questions

1. When was the last time I intentionally tried to reflect Christ's love in my workplace, and how did it go?
2. What challenges make it difficult for me to be a light for Christ at work, and how can I handle them differently?
3. In what ways do my words and actions influence my coworkers, whether positively or negatively?
4. Who in my workplace might need encouragement, prayer, or simply someone to show them kindness today?
5. If someone at work asked me about my faith, would I feel ready to share? If not, what can I do to prepare?
