

Dear Seniors and Parents/Guardians,

We are in the home stretch of the school year. Make sure you are coming to school and if you are concerned about your grades, speak with your teacher.

## **Senior Requirements**

An email was sent out from Juliana Scricco earlier this week about the end-of-the-year senior information. Seniors will need to sign and return the [Senior Graduation Contract](#) to their counselor before graduation. They will also need to complete the [Senior Graduation Survey](#). Counselors will be presenting this in health and PE classes on May 20 and 21.

Students will also need to log into Scoir and update their decisions (accepted, denied, waitlisted, deferred, etc) and set the school they will be attending in the fall. If this is not done, then the final transcript will not be sent. If you are not going to attend college, you can still let us know whether you are going into the workforce, entering the military, or taking time off.

Final transcripts will be sent to the college you indicate in Scoir as the Enrolling college. These will automatically be sent after graduation. You do not need to print out any reports, all of that information will be sent by Scoir.

For concurrent enrollment classes, you will need to request a transcript directly from that institution. For example, RVCC concurrent enrollment or Seton Hall Project Acceleration. Please see this [link](#) for more information. This is something your counselor cannot do on your behalf.

## **Attendance**

Attendance is an important part of school. Please be aware that 12 unexcused absences in a full-year course and 6 unexcused absences in a half-year course result in loss of credit for the class. Additionally, 3 tardies to class will result in 1 unexcused absence. Losing credit in classes will result in students needing to complete credit restoration.
