Players enter online in the Junior Tournament Section of the Tennis Canada web site at <a href="https://www.tenniscanada.com">www.tenniscanada.com</a> , or on the OTA web site. The entry link will be available soon.  Players who qualify will not be required to pay an additional entry fee for the U18 Fischer Indoor Junior Nationals Main Event.

ELIGIBILITY	Players who have competed in the Junior Nationals provincial qualifying process and not gained entry to the Junior







	Nationals, or players approved by their respective Provincial Association are eligible.
RULES & REGULATIONS	The Tennis Canada Code of Conduct will be enforced.  Matches will be the best of 3 tiebreak sets.
RANKING POINTS	National Bank Ranking points may be earned for the Main draw only. Ranking points will not be awarded for the Qualifying tournament.
ACCEPTANCE LISTS	Acceptance lists will be forwarded to the Provincial Associations and posted on the Tennis Canada web site on March 23. The top 32 ranked boys & girls entered based on the U18 National Bank Rankings as of March 22 will be accepted into the Qualifying event.  Players not accepted into the Qualifying tournament will be placed in an order of priority based on the National Bank Rankings as per the above criteria. Withdrawals from the Qualifying tournament will be replaced with players from this list.
SIGN-IN & DRAW	Sign-in: for all entered players who are on the Qualifying list and any non-entered players who wish to be considered for the draw, but did not register by the deadline:  March 30, 1:00 p.m 4:00 p.m. EST  The above mentioned players must sign-in online at the link below. Players must upload a photo of their passport information page or permanent residency card at sign-in, to verify their Canadian status.  SIGN-IN  Draw: The draw will be conducted immediately following the close of sign-in.  Alternates: the referee will announce a sign-in time for the first day of play for any Alternates who wish to be considered







	for the Qualifying event, should a potential spot open up due to injury or withdrawal.
FORMAT & SCHEDULE	4 boys and 4 girls will qualify for the Main Draw, April 2 – April 7. Two singles matches will be played on March 31, followed by the final round on April 1 to determine the qualifiers.

ADDITIONAL JUNIOR NATIONALS SPOTS	Additional Junior Nationals Spots: Withdrawals from the Under 18 Junior Nationals main draw prior to the Qualification tournament draw will be filled as follows:  1. If the withdrawal is from the base Provincial Association allocation, the spot goes back to the Province  2. If the withdrawal is from a player who gained entry through a NTC, NJTP, or Out of Country Spot, the spot is returned to Tennis Canada and not redistributed.







	Withdrawals from the Under 18 Junior Nationals main draw after the Qualifying tournament draw has been made, may be filled beginning with the losing quarter finalists as follows:  1. Players losing in the final round of Qualifying who are interested in being considered for a spot at the Under 18 Junior Nationals must sign in with the Referee no later than 30 minutes after the last qualifying match has concluded. An order of priority for additional spots will be created by the Referee based on a random draw of the eligible players who have signed in.  Notes:  Players may be added to the Junior Nationals main draw from the Qualifying tournament to ensure even draw sizes.  Tennis Canada reserves the right to add additional spots to the Junior Nationals main draw due to unforeseen circumstances. This will only occur when extra spots are available.
