- Join the "DC Cooks!" group and RSVP to "Attend" the "All About Seasonings and Oils" event
- Go back to the "DC Cooks!" homepage, and leave a review

Metrics: Errors made, hesitations, time to complete tasks, number of errors/misclicks

"see more" on group review page – organizer's profile review bounce back (blue flashing prototype indicator) instead of being able to see full review section

Wanted to click "see more" (or see most helpful reviews first)

"If a feature isn't open to certain people, there should be a popup that comes up if it's a private feature." Lack of scrolling bar (re: the error when executing task #10 to check out the group reviews)

Profile pic – verification (may prove to be an issue for some users)

I forgot to reword the "group review" task in question on this form (should've changed "check out" to "find")

User didn't realize the page scrolled vertically, thought the rest of the review section was hidden behind the "see more" link (build another screen for the next prototype just in case?)

The user mentioned the possibility of profile pic uploads being an issue for some users. I asked the user to tell me more, and they mentioned that some apps ask for photo verification. I then asked the user whether they had experience with that feature on other apps, and when they answered in the affirmative, I asked them to tell me more. They talked about how on some apps (including dating apps they've used), users are not only asked to upload profile pictures so their identity can be verified, but

they're also asked to take and upload a selfie with a specific pose for their profile to be verified. (possible safety and security feature?)

Next Steps:

- Make high contrast changes to the social media buttons (profile customization feature)
- Change replicated "Baking" interest tab to "Whiskey"
- Track number of people joining groups
- Track number of people RSVPing to events
- Track number of people attending said events
- Track how people are using the review feature
- Use heat maps to determine how people are using the site, how long and how often they spend in certain areas (ex, the review section does it increase user engagement?)
- "Reading reviews" into "joining a group" aspect what is the percentage of people who join a group after reading group reviews?
