

ANNOUNCER SCRIPT –Primary Spring Concert – Thursday, May 18, 2023 – 6:00-6:30pm

- Emily (23):** Welcome to tonight's concert. We would first like to acknowledge that we are hosted on the lands of the Mississaugas of the Anishinaabe, the Haudenosaunee Confederacy and the Wendat. We also recognize the enduring presence of all First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples. And now please stand for the singing of "Oh Canada"
- Isabelle (26):** The students have worked very hard putting together tonight's concert and we trust that you will listen quietly to all the performances. Please note that **nobody** will be permitted to exit or enter the gym during the performances out of respect for the students performing on stage!
- Amelia (26):** We also ask all audience members to be mindful of those around you by refraining from holding up your cameras or other recording devices during the concert, so that you don't block the view of others. There is somebody recording the concert, which will be shared with families. Now please sit back and enjoy!!

GRADE 1 & 1/2 CLASSES

- Nelle (21):** The grade 1 and 1-2 classes will begin tonight's concert. We welcome to the stage Ms. Mehta's class (room 9), Mr. Rieper's class (room 13), and Ms. Pan's class (room 14).
- Ayane (23):** They will be performing 3 numbers for you tonight. First, they will perform a little skit called "The Tulip Bulbs". This will be followed by a song called "Springtime is Coming". They will then end with a song called "Give it All You've Got" which is about not only trying your best, but is also about working together, and celebrating everybody's diverse and unique gifts, talents, and contributions.

PRIMARY CHOIR:

- Amelia (26):** Great job! Next, we welcome the primary choir to the stage. These students have been practicing every Monday during their lunch recess time!
- Aadip (27):** The primary choir will begin with a song called "Butterflies." For this song, try to imagine walking through a Butterfly Conservatory, such as the one located near Niagara Falls.
- Paige (23):** Next, the primary choir will perform a popular folk song called "Michael Finnigin". However, the students have changed the song to "Arthur Finnigin" and have changed the final verse to be about a fictional boy named Arthur who went to Wilkinson.
- Emily (23):** Next, the primary choir will perform a song called "Trolls" that is based on the fictional troll characters as featured in folklore from Scandinavia and other Norse settlements.
- Nelle (21):** Next, the primary choir will perform the world cup version of the song "Wavin' Flag".
- Eva (23):** Next, the primary choir will perform the song called "Life's a Happy Song" from the 2011 movie called "The Muppets".
- Ayane (23):** For their final song, the primary choir will perform the pop hit, "Unstoppable" by Sia.

All students must be picked up immediately after the concert, as the teachers are needed elsewhere to help with the junior concert.
