The Listener in this story uses a wheelchair. I haven't mentioned any specific details, other than that their legs are paralyzed. If you'd like to imagine a reason for their disability, feel free to add a little something to the story!

[M4A] Taking you out for a date in your wheelchair [disabled Listener] [pampering you] [picnic] [playful] [wholesome] [comfort]

Synopsis: Your boyfriend is in a good mood today. And he shows it by wanting to make your day perfect. Because he loves you, and he knows you deserve all the love in this world.

Speaker information: The Speaker's been with the Listener long enough to know how to help without hovering. He's always looking out for them, but never makes them feel like they can't handle things themselves.

Listener information: The Listener is disabled, their legs are paralyzed. Because of that they use a wheelchair. There's no reason for their disability mentioned in this story.

—

[It's morning, birds chirping. The Listener is still in bed when the Speaker comes in, door opens quietly]

(quietly) Baby? Darling? Are you awake?

pause

(smiling, to himself) Aww, look at you, so cozy and cuddly.

long pause

(whispering) Babyyy, I made breakfast.

pause

(chuckles) Oh, look who's suddenly awake. Did you sleep well?

pause

That's good. Are you ready for the day? I've planned something very nice for us to do.

pause

I can't tell you yet, baby. You'll have to wait and see.

pause

(chuckles) It'll be worth it, I promise. Look, the sun is shining already, it'll be a nice warm day, perfect for what I have planned. Now, may I help you get dressed and get out of bed?

pause

(amused) Oh, come on, darling. It's such a beautiful morning. You don't want to spend the whole day in bed, do you?

pause

Are you not the slightest curious about what I have planned for us today?

pause

(playfully) Ah, I can see it in your eyes. I know you are. Come on. Let's get you out of bed.

[Speaker pulls away the blanket]

What do you want to wear today? I'll get it for you.

pause

Hmm, sounds good.

[Speaker walks to the closet and opens it, then takes out the clothes]

(while grabbing the clothes, smiling) Your favorite shirt... <My> shirt... And short pants.

[Speaker walks back to the bed]

Alright. Got your clothes. We'll do your pants first, alright?

short pause

Good.

[Rustling as the Speaker changes the Listener's pants]

There we go. And now the shirt. Wait, I'll help you sit up.

pause

Perfect. Now lift your arms.

short pause

Just like this...

[Rustling as the Speaker changes the Listener's shirt]

And boom. Done. You look perfect, babe.

pause

(chuckling) I mean it. I always mean it. ^ Now, let's get you out of bed. I'll help you.

pause

Sure, I know you can do it yourself. But today, I want to do everything for you. I want to be at your service for everything.

pause

(smiling) No reason. Except that I love you. And I just feel like pampering you.

pause

(softly) Hey, you know I'm not doing this because I think you're not capable of doing it yourself. I know you are. I just wanted to give you a day where you could completely relax. Just because.

pause

(chuckles) I promise. No other reason. So, may I help you out of bed?

pause

Thank you, baby. Wait, let me secure the brakes first. We wouldn't want your wheelchair to roll away, right? (chuckles)

[Speaker secures the brakes]

Perfect. I'll lift you up now, okay?

[Speaker grunts slightly as he lifts the Listener out of bed and into the wheelchair]

There we go. And your legs... (soft grunting) One leg. And the other one. Great. Are you comfortable? Wait, you're leaning a bit to the right. ^ Here, is that better?

pause

Good. (slightly guilty) Now, I might have to make a confession... I didn't make breakfast.

pause

(laughing) I'm sorry, baby. I had to lure you out of bed!

pause

No, no, wait. Don't go back there. (laughing) Baby. You'll get your breakfast. Just not... now. First, we've got a place to be.

pause

Yeah. I'll take us somewhere and then we can eat breakfast.

pause

Uh, yes... I want to eat out. Any problem with that?

pause

(amused) Oh, you're hungry <now>? Hm... I guess we have to hurry up then.

pause

I'm telling you, it'll be worth it. Now let me just... turn you around like this... And-

pause

Nuh-uh. I'll push your wheelchair.

pause

(chuckling) Too much? Alright, fine. But when we're outside, you'll have to let me push your wheelchair. Because I won't tell you where we're going.

pause

Good. Then let's go get your shoes on.

pause

Huh? (realizing) Oh, sure. I don't think you need it but if you want to get ready in the bathroom first, then go on.

pause

(chuckling) Okay, you're right. Maybe at least doing your hair would be good.

[Speaker and Listener move out of the bedroom to the bathroom]

Alright, where's your- [Listener interrupts]

pause

(sighs, playfully) Come on. I said I want to do everything for you today. My plan isn't working out if you don't let me.

pause

Fine, fine. Then get ready. I'll wait outside. And don't take too long.

[Speaker walks away. Timeskip. Listener comes out of the bathroom]

(teasing) Oh, that was fast. Did you hurry up because your curiosity got the best of you?

pause

(playfully annoyed) Of course. You hurried because you're hungry. How else could it be? ^ Can we get your shoes on then?

pause

Alright. What shoes do you want to wear?

pause

Uhh, good choice. Here, I'll get them for you.

[Speaker puts Listener's shoes on]

And... one shoe, just like that... ^ And the other one... ^ wonderful. I guess you're all set.

pause

(amused) What? Baby! Look outside! You won't need a jacket with the sun shining like that. Now, let me just put on my shoes...

pause

(while putting on shoes) We'll be there in no time, promise.

pause

I can't tell you where we're going.

pause

(chuckling) Yeah. I know you hate surprises. But I promise it's nothing huge, okay? I just want us to have a nice day where we can enjoy the good weather.

pause

Okay, one second now. I gotta get something.

[Speaker walks away and comes back with a backpack]

Yep. Done. We can go.

pause

Babyyy, stop being so curious. You'll find out soon enough what's in that backpack. Can we leave now?

pause

(realizing) Oh, yes, right. The keys. Thanks, babes.

[Speaker grabs the keys]

Got 'em. Let's go.

[Speaker and Listener get outside]

(playfully) May I push your wheelchair now, darling?

pause

Thanks.

pause

(chuckling) No, I'm still not telling you where we're going. You'll see soon enough.

pause

(laughing) I know you're hungry. (mumbling) More hangry...

pause

(laughing) Sorry. Please be patient for a bit longer, okay? And then you can eat as much as you want.

pause

Thank you, baby. Now, what do you say to the weather? It's nice isn't it? After a whole week of rain, this sunny weather is a welcome change.

pause

You're right, the trees are blooming. They're beautiful. ^ Not as beautiful as you of course.

pause

(laughing) Too cheesy? Still true though.

pause

(chuckling) I love you, too, baby.

[They move in silence for a while]

Oh, look at that, we're almost there.

pause

You guessed it, babe. We're going to the park.

pause

(amused) Well, what do you think we could do in a park with a nice, open meadow like this?

pause

(smiling) Does that smile mean you have an idea?

pause

Ah, a picnic? Well, babes, you are totally right about that! (chuckles) I woke up this morning, saw the sun shining, and thought, 'Yep, gotta have to do this with the love of my life.'

pause

So... I got up, ran to the store, and grabbed us a few things. Like I said, it's not much, but I just thought it'd be nice to spend some time together. Figured it'd be a bit more relaxing than a cafe, you know?

pause

(smiling) You like it? I'm glad. ^ Now, how about we sit down under that tree? It'd be a bit cooler than in the sun and you could lean back against the trunk. What do you say?

pause

Good idea? Then come on.

[Speaker and Listener continue moving until they reach the spot]

Looks like a good spot. I wonder why no one else has taken it yet. Anyway, let me just get the blanket from my backpack.

[Rustling as the Speaker opens the backpack and gets the blanket out]

There we go.

pause

Hm? No, no, I'll do it. You don't have to do anything today.

long pause

(repeating) You'd feel awkward if you just sat there and watched? Well... (sighs) alright, fine. I guess that's understandable. ^ Here, I'll unfold the blanket. [Rustling] Now, you take these two corners... and I'll take the other two... like this. And now we can just spread it out right here.

long pause

Perfect.

pause

Yeah, sure. I can help with your side.

pause

There we go. May I help you down onto the blanket?

pause

(smiling) Alright. Here, I'll secure the brakes... ^ And now, let me-... (soft groan, as he lifts them) and on the ground... ^ Nice. You can lean back against the tree.

short pause

Comfy? Oh, wait. I also got...

[Rustling as the Speaker gets a pillow out of the backpack]

... A small pillow you can put between your back and the tree!

pause

(chuckles) Yes, of course. I always think of everything.

pause

(amused) Oh, you wouldn't believe how much stuff goes into that backpack.

pause

Are you comfy now? If not, tell me.

long pause

(soft laugh) Okay, okay. We'll get to the food. I think I made you wait long enough.

pause

(playfully sarcastic) Glad you can agree on that.

pause

So... I've got lots of stuff. I'll just put everything on the blanket and you eat whatever and how much you want. Sounds good?

pause

Wonderful. Then...

[Speaker begins to unpack the backpack]

(while unpacking) First things first. Sandwiches. The way you like them obviously... uh... croissants, normal and with chocolate or almond... danishes with raspberry filling... Oh, didn't forget to pack some fruits of course. We've got apples, pears, grapes, bananas... uh... strawberries as well...

pause

Hm? (wide smile) Yeah. I guess I've packed a lot of things. But this is our breakfast, I want us to be satiated after this. Now, I've also brought some muesli and yoghurt, some bagels... Honey and jam for the croissants... Oh, and something to drink of course. You can choose between coffee, orange juice and water.

pause

Anything else...? Nope... I think that was it.

long pause

(realizing) Uh... silverware...? For what?

pause

Okay, fine. Then we won't eat the muesli...

pause

(repeating) What about the honey and jam? I don't know, just dip it in.

pause

(slightly whiny) Don't laugh at me. I thought of everything else!

pause

(playfully, smiling) You got ten fingers. I'm sure you can use at least two of them to eat.

pause

(laughing) Well, screw the muesli! There's enough other stuff to eat!

pause

(confused) Huh? Cups? Oh, come on, babe. Just drink from the bottle.

pause

I didn't bring cups because we don't need them!

long pause

(playfully grumpy) Fine, I forgot them, too...

pause

(playfully) But hey, at least I didn't forget you at home! (laughing)

long pause

(soft sigh) Wait, let me just... (grunt) ... sit down next to you... perfect. ^ Alright. So, I am deeply sorry that you cannot eat everything I brought, darling. But I hope it's still enough for you. If not, I'll go get whatever you want right now.

pause

It's fine? Oh, you're so gracious. How did I deserve you?

pause

(chuckling) Well, however it happened, I'm glad it did. Dig in.

[Speaker and Listener start eating]

(sighs contentedly) It really is a nice day... And it's pretty calm here even though the weather is so good.

pause

(smiling) Yeah, I don't mind either. I enjoy just being here with you, in our owl little world... It makes everything seem a bit less... overwhelming...

long pause

Thank you for coming with me, baby.

pause

(chuckles) I know you didn't really have a choice. But still... Maybe it's not just about today... You're always there for me. And I hope I can do the same for you.

pause

You think I do? Even if I forget silverware and cups?

pause

(chuckling) Thanks. I'm glad it's still enough.

pause

(playfully) Oh, more than enough? That's nice to hear.

long pause

Yeah sure, I can give you a croissant. Which one do you want?

pause

Alright. ^ Here you go.

long pause

(amused) You want to feed me a grape? Okay.

[Listener eats the grape]

Mhh, delicious. Not too sour.

pause

Another? (chuckling) Alright, fine.

[Speaker eats another grape]

Thanks, babe.

long pause, they continue eating

(excited) Oh, these danishes are great. You gotta try them!

pause

(laughing) No, no. It's my turn to feed you. Come on.

long pause

(chuckling) There we go. They're awesome, right?

pause

(amused) Wait, you got something... right there. Let me just... ^ Alright, it's gone.

pause

(chuckling) No problem, babes.

long pause

(softly) You okay?

pause

Hm? Some people are looking? At us?

pause

At you? Why?

pause

(repeating) The wheelchair? (softly teasing) Maybe they're also just looking because I've got the most attractive partner in the world.

pause

(chuckling) It's true. ^ (softly) But, baby... look at me.

short pause

Even if they <did> look because of the wheelchair, why does it matter? You know, sometimes people are just a bit curious. That doesn't mean they're judging you... Okay?

pause

(smiling) Besides, who cares about their opinion? I'm your boyfriend, my opinion is more important. And I never considered your inability to walk a deciding factor in my love for you. My heart made its choice for reasons far deeper than that.

long pause

(amused) I'm not being mushy! Baby, I'm just trying to tell you that there are far more important things about a person than their mobility. It doesn't make you less worthy or anything.

pause

(softly) Hey, I know it sometimes feels like everyone is watching you because the way you move through the world is different from most people. And sometimes that can be hard to ignore. But in those moments, I want you to think of me, okay? Because when I look at you, it's not because of the wheelchair. I look at you because my heart does that little jump – every single time I see you.

pause

(interrupting) No, wait. I don't care if I'm being gushy, let me finish. ^ Your disability doesn't define you. That wheelchair doesn't define you. I know there are things that are harder to do when you're in a wheelchair, some even impossible. But you never gave up because of that and <that's> what I love about you. So don't start doubting your worth now. You have a strong mind and a stronger will. Don't let anything – or anyone – ever stop you, okay? Never.

long pause

And I'll always be here for you. Through the good and the bad. You don't have to prove anything to me. I love you just the way you are.

long pause

(smiling) Yeah, sure. You can have a hug.

[Speaker hugs Listener]

(quietly) I love you, too, baby. Never forget that.

pause

Do you feel a bit better?

pause

(soft chuckle) Oh, you feel a little fluttery? I think that's okay.

pause

(smiling) Anything for you, baby. I'll remind you how much I love you every day. As long as you can take it.

pause

(chuckle) If you think you can take it forever then I won't complain.

pause

(repeating) Ah, only if I'm not being too sappy? (dramatic sigh) Can't make any promises. But I'll try my best. Just for you.

pause

(smiling) You're adorable.

short pause

(soft laugh) okay, okay. I'll stop.

long pause

(soft sigh) Mind if I rest my head on your shoulder?

pause

Thanks. ^ Hm... so cozy...

pause

You think I'm cute? (teasing) Who's the mushy one now?

pause

I don't mind it though. You can keep going. (sighing) I'll just close my eyes and listen to you being all lovey-dovey.

pause

What? No, I'm not sleepy!

pause

Fine, maybe a little bit. But I've also been up early just to prepare everything! But I promise I won't fall asleep. I want to sit here with you, eat, talk and watch strangers. I won't miss this for any sleep in the world.

pause

You already said I'm cute. Think of something else.

long pause

(gentle chuckle) Wow, "the best boyfriend in the world"? Now that's something I could get used to hearing. ^ Thanks, babe.

pause

Are you still comfortable with the tree in your back?

pause

I know you have the pillow but it's not very thick.

pause

Hm... How about we just switch places and you can lay down with your head on my lap? ^ Yeah, that's a good idea. (while getting up) I'll just put all of this food aside and then you can scoot down.

long pause

Wait, I'll help with your legs... [Listener lays down] (chuckles) wonderful. Now I'll lean against the tree and you can put your head on my lap.

pause

And... there you go. Comfy?

pause

Yes? Good. (quietly) I've got you...

pause

Mind if I play with your hair?

pause

(chuckles) It's going to make you sleepy? Well, I don't mind. You can rest. I'll keep an eye on our food so it doesn't run away while you're napping.

pause

(playfully) Oh, and of course, I'll also keep an eye on you so no one decides to steal you away!

pause

(soft laugh) <You> are a dork. (softly) Now, close your eyes, baby. Let me hold you, just for a while.

long pause

(quietly) I should probably shut up before I say something sappy again.

long pause

You want to hear it? Hm... I just wanted to say that you're a wonderful person... And I'm so lucky to have you in my life.

pause

(repeating) More cute than sappy? (softly) What a relief.

long pause

(quietly) I love you, baby. More than anything... Now get some rest. I'll hold you...
