ISA is located on University of York's Campus East on Lakeside Way, next to the Piazza Building.

## Getting here

### Bus

The University recommends using public transport when possible as part of our sustainability goals.

Travel between campus and York city centre takes about 20 minutes. The main bus routes are [FirstBus 66 and 67](#) and the Campus East Interchange stop is a [4 minute walk](#) from ISA. Bus tickets can be purchased on board or on the [FirstBus App](#).

**Note:** Taking the 66/67 bus between Campus West and Campus East is free of charge.

### Cycling

### Taxi

One of the local taxi services is Streamline, contactable on 01904 656565. The best pick up / drop off location is the Piazza Service Entrance. Peak times for taxis in York are between 8 - 9am and 3.30 - 5.30pm, so it's best to book in advance.

### Car

The nearest car parks are [Kimberlow Car Park](#) and [Field Lane Car Park](#). These are pay and display facilities, and you can pay by debit/credit card or via your mobile phone using [PayByPhone](#). [Parking information](#). If there are no spaces available in either car park, there is overflow parking available at the [Sports Village](#), at the back of the pay & display parking.

### Accessibility

There is parking available directly outside the Institute which can be made available for those who require accessible parking.
