Subject: Camp United We Stand needs

CUWS needs coming up for our move from St. Dunstan's in Shoreline to St. Teresa of Calcutta east of Woodinville starting Jan 9. Some of these are critical now because the KC fire marshal has ruled that we cannot heat the sleeping tents with propane heaters.

1. An electrician to advise us on options for space heaters (ceramic, oil-filled?) that we could use in tents for heating (either between the 12 x 20 foot big tents and the smaller camping tents inside them, or inside the smaller tents. Need to be safe enough around clutter. We will have two 50 amp outlets to connect to via extension cords and spider boxes. We will have 18 big tents and 35 small ones. May not have enough juice for each one, but how many could we serve. Also need juice for lights and the office trailer.
2. Indoor space for a week the size of two-car garage, with good ventilation, heated to 55 degrees in which we can build frames and pour chemicals to build light-weight, fire resistant, insulation panels for the dining tent.
3. Blankets, sleeping bags, comforters.
4. A flatbed trailer to move the portable shower. Probably Jan 9 or 10 – ask Christopher
5. A caravan of SUVs to help move individuals and their stuff on Jan 10 and help set up tents upon arrival.
6. Folks at either site to take down tents starting Jan 9 at St. Dunstan's and set up tents at St. Teresa starting afternoon of Jan 9 and on Jan 10 and maybe Jan 11.
7. Wood chips to put down on our walkway on top of the lawn. Delivery on Jan 12 after our move would be ideal. Need enough 4 cubic yards.
- 7.5 In addition, since we will not have heat in the sleeping tents for a while, hand warmers and blankets, sleeping bags, comforters would be very useful.
8. Food on moving days and afterwards for 20-30 people. Sign up at:
