- * ANY fidget devices such as spinners, chew necklaces, Thera putty, cubes, slime and stress balls are not allowed to be brought to school or allowed on the bus by students. If a repeated issue arises, items may remain at school until parents are able to come pick them up. Fidget items may be utilized at school if a student has a documented 504 Plan or an IEP that calls for such a device.

Helpful Information:

- ❖ All students with a Senior Release NEED to have a senior release form turned in otherwise they will not be allowed to leave.

- Students who are participating in extracurricular activities: You are required to be in school for half a day in order to participate. Also, any students who attend home events will not be allowed back in IF they leave.
