### REQUIREMENTS:

1. PARENT OR GRANDPARENT IS AND HAS BEEN A CONTINUOUS MEMBER OF THE DES MOINES COUNTY CATTLEMEN'S ASSOCIATION
2. APPLICANT WILL ATTEND A 2 OR 4 YEAR SCHOOL WITH A PREFERENCE TO MAJORING IN BUT NOT LIMITED TO A AGRICULTURAL RELATED FIELD. A TRADE SCHOOL WILL ALSO BE CONSIDERED.
3. SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE FOR \$500 OR AN AMOUNT TO BE DETERMINED BASED ON THE NUMBER OF APPLICANTS AWARDED
4. SELECTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP WINNER WILL BE DETERMINED BY A COMMITTEE FROM THE BOARD OF THE DES MOINES COUNTY CATTLEMEN
5. A 2.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE IS REQUIRED
6. LIST OF 4-H AND FFA ACTIVITIES ESPECIALLY AS IT PERTAINS TO THE BEEF INDUSTRY IS REQUIRED WITH THE APPLICATION.
7. COMMUNITY SERVICE INVOLVEMENT LISTED
8. There is not a set form for the scholarship. Please include a written page telling about your family, high school activities and involvement, grade point, 4-H or FFA activities, community service and your future plans for continuing education.
