

Volunteer Opportunities

NewHope Students is one of the most rewarding places you can serve in our NEWHOPE movement! The great thing about NewHope Students is there are many different places to serve our students and their families, ultimately showing them how wonderful having a relationship with Jesus can be! Where do you fit in? Let's take a look:

Life Group Leader - Comes prepared, having read the lesson/student leader page beforehand (as applicable), prays for his/her students during the week, and engages with students and their parents before, during, and after service every week. All life group leaders must enjoy working with students and maintain an encouraging and patient attitude. As a Life Group Leader, you are required to be there every Wednesday. Consistency is key in Student Ministry. Life Group Leaders must enjoy working with students in grades 6-12 and maintain an encouraging and patient attitude. All life group leaders must be a members of NEWHOPE Church.

Life Group Assistant - A life group helper assists the life group leader with the students in the life group rooms. They will also pray for and connect with their students at least once during the week. As a Life Group Assistant, you are required to be there at least 2 Wednesdays per month. Consistency is key in Student Ministry. Life Group Assistants must enjoy working with students in grades 6-12 and maintain an encouraging and patient attitude.

Worship Team- A NewHope Worship volunteer assists the Worship Leader and Producer on NewHope Nights in Students. They will help lead students into worshiping the Lord through vocal, instrumental, or production talent. This team will be led by the Worship Leader. You must bring excitement, energy, and passion to the team as students will look up to you and learn how and why to worship the Lord through you.

Guest Team- Helps greet our students and makes them feel welcomed, valued, and known. They are to create a welcoming and warm environment so that students can experience community with other students and Jesus on their level.

Event Prep- Will help prep and set up for student events. They will work together in creating a unique environment for students to engage in community, and engage in God's word. They will work closely with the Student Director and help each event run with excellence.

Security Team- Helps monitor hallways, walks students to vehicles if needed, and ensures that students are where they are supposed to be.

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
