1. Introduction

At Kitchener Minor Baseball Association (KMBA), we are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our members, volunteers, and website visitors. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect your personal information in accordance with applicable privacy laws in Ontario. We will update this policy periodically to reflect any changes in our practices or legal requirements.

2. Information We Collection

We may collect personal information such as name, contact details, date of birth, photos, and payment information when you register as a member, volunteer, or participant in our programs. Additionally, we may collect non-personal information such as IP addresses, browser type, and browsing patterns to improve our website and services. As our program is delivered to children, we do collect personal information from children with parental consent.

3. Use of Information

We use the information collected to deliver our programs and services, communicate with members and participants, process payments, and manage our operations effectively. Personal information may also be used for marketing purposes, with consent, to provide you with information about our upcoming events, fundraisers, and initiatives.

4. Sharing of Information

We will not sell, trade, or rent personal information to third parties. Personal information may be shared with service providers who assist us in operating our organization and delivering services. We may also disclose information when required by law or to protect our rights, property, or safety of others.

5. Security

We implement reasonable security measures to protect personal information from unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. Despite efforts, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure. Therefore, we cannot guarantee absolute security of your information. We will update this policy periodically to reflect any changes in our practices or legal requirements.

6. Choice

Members and participants have the right to access, update, or correct personal information in our records. Requests to have information deleted from our database is subject to legal and contractual obligations. All members and participants can opt-out of receiving marketing communications at any time by following the instructions provided in the communication or by contacting us directly.
