- The Learning Den provides tutoring for all registered students in KSAS and WSE
- Tutoring is conducted in small group format, with a maximum of six students in each group
- Tutors review course-specific material and encourage students to ask questions and exchange information

- Tutors can assist students with:
 - Review and strengthening of subject-specific material knowledge

<u>Pilot</u>

- PILOT is a loose acronym for peer-led-team learning.
- In the PILOT program, students are organized into study teams of six to 10 members who meet weekly to work problems together.

- PILOT aims to actively teach and demonstrate how collaborative learning uses contributions from individuals to benefit a group.

- All math courses (see below) will register August 10-14, 2020 because PILOT will be a required part of the class.
- All members meet twice per week for 1.5-2 hours weekly as a group with their team leader.
