Whistler Trip

- Final payments: Due Feb 1st (about 7-8 stragglers left, but should be mostly paid up by end of tomorrow)
- Chaperone Interest Intent Email sent...10 confirmed chaperones...criminal checks are rolling in, 5 back-up chaperones confirmed. [89 students, need 10:1 ratio]
- thought if there is another District Employee was going to come; however, likely won't happen as there is no CEA in class this year. And, there is no other hotel room slot available.
- Rooming is sorted, all permission forms are in.
- -\$350 final trip cost per students final announcement has not been made, however, this amount is pending as there may be the need to have another restaurant meal as "taco party" fell through.
 - Originally the trip was planned over \$600; after fundraising, the payment went down to about \$337, so to leave wiggle room, it was made \$350.00.
 - If parents/students overpaid, the cheque will be reimbursed AFTER the trip is over
 - If fundraising was exceeding this amount, student may not need to make a payment.
 - Fundraising considered cash payments

There will be taco parties (restaurant pulled out and change of staff); pizza dinners; pizza on a way home—organizers are getting very creative!
