# [book summary]

Kindness snippet jar is a story about a little snippet who desperately wants to live in a kindness jar because he learns that it brings kindness to the world, but can't figure out the right words to help spread kindness.

## [book bag overview]

We are spreading kindness at school and at home with our own kindness snippets. At home, our families will put our kind acts into our notebooks and at school we will create our own kindness jar.

### **Bag Contents:**

- book
- bag of small colored paper squares or sticky notes
- journal
- glue stick

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Read Kindness Snippet Jar by Diane Alber.
- 2. Discuss with your family different ways you can show kindness at home and at school.
- 3. Ask your guardians to write down on one of the snippets (sticky notes) whenever they see you do a kind act at home.
- 4. At the end of the week, glue all your snippets into one of the pages in the notebook.
- 5. Bring the notebook back at the end of the week so others can spread kindness at home next week.

#### **Extended Learning:**

1. Let's extend our kindness to the classroom! Anytime you see someone do a kind act for someone else, ask your teacher to help you write it out (unless you can write it
