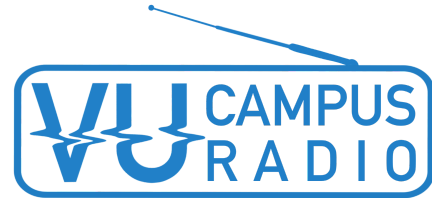


Vacancy: Editor-in-chief



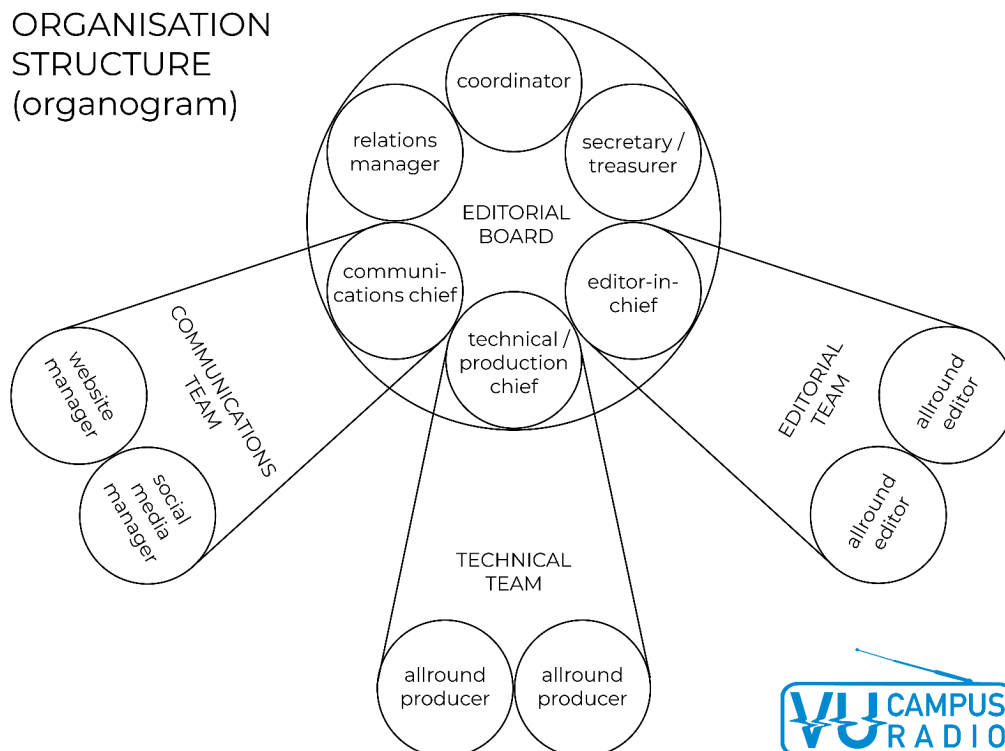

And from there, broadcasts and podcasts are produced for an audience consisting of students, employees, teachers, alumni and other interested parties. The Editorial Board is the organizational centre of VU Campusradio and it mainly consists of students. This board is engaged in recruiting new show makers, putting together broadcast schedules, training new show makers and promoting our content. Starting in October we would like to welcome a new editor-in-chief to the board. We estimate the workload to be around 10 hours a week. As editor-in-chief you don't necessarily have your own radio show, but you are in charge of supporting all show makers in developing their content – together with the Editorial Team, which you'll lead. Knowledge of technical skills is not necessary. Together we'll work on our own productions and help students create new ones.

Currently the Editorial Board positions of [Secretary / Treasurer](#) and [Communications/Social Chief](#) are also vacant. Shortly we'll be recruiting two allround editors, two allround producers, a website manager and social media manager as well, to form our new Editorial, Technical and Communications Teams. The [latter positions](#) are less time consuming and aren't financially compensated.

We are looking for both English- and Dutch-speaking candidates. The term of office is the duration of the academic year, which ends in August 2026. By mutual agreement the term can be extended to include the following academic year.

Your tasks and responsibilities will consist of ...

- ... guiding new and running show makers in their content development;
 - ⇒ brainstorming show concepts with potential show makers;
 - ⇒ helping the show makers in their creative development;
 - ⇒ giving notes and feedback on shows;
 - ⇒ supervising the development of all shows from proposal to finished episodes;
- directing our Editorial Team, thus managing our allround editors;
- and overseeing compliance with our code of ethics.

Your profile:

- You are either a VU student or VU alumnus/alumna;
- are preferably fluent in both Dutch and English;
- are passionate about editorial work;
- are a good communicator and enjoy working in a team environment;
- can easily combine the editor-in-chief tasks with your current activities;
- have a proactive approach;
- and don't mind working with flexible hours.

This position involves a yearly compensation of 2000 €.
