Greek and Latin number prefixes

mono, uni, bi, tri, quad, quart, quint, pent, sex, hex, sept, hept, oct, nov, non, dec, cent, milli

Latin and Greek parallels

sub (Latin) and hypo (Greek) = “below, under, up from under”

trans (Latin) and meta (Greek) = “across, change”

luc, lumen (Latin) and photo (Greek) = “light”

spec, spic, spect (Latin) and scop (Greek) = “look”

Paired Latin bases

bon, bene = “good” **AND** mal(e) = “bad, wrong”

matr(i), matern = “mother” **AND** patri, patern = “father”

bell = “war” **AND** pac = “peace” **AND** plac = “calm”

audi, audit = “hear, listen” **AND** loqu, locut = “speak, talk”

Advanced Latin suffixes

-ose, -ous, -eous, -ious = “full of”

-ant, -ent = “having the quality of”

-ence, -ency, -ance, -ancy = “state or quality of”
