METODOLOGY

The author is required to explain the type of research as part of experimental, correlational, comparative, explanatory, or exploratory research. It is also important to mention the types of software and various tools used during the study, including the brand names. The author should also explain the various research conditions encountered in the field, especially in answering assumptions and theories used as references (qualitative approach) or testing hypotheses and the foundational theories of the variables being tested (quantitative approach). This section should be clear enough for readers to replicate the research under similar conditions. *The content of the article for the Jurnal Netnografi Komunikasi (JNK) should use Gadugi font, size 12pt, and 1.5 line spacing.*

FINDING AND DISCUSSION

The author is expected to provide a logical and scientific analysis of the research findings. Evidence should be presented to support the analysis by citing previous scientific articles written by other researchers and/or grounding the analysis in existing theories. *The content of the article for the Jurnal Netnografi Komunikasi (JNK) should use Gadugi font, size 12pt, and 1.5 line spacing. In order to enhance the quality of the informative article and make it easier for readers, the article content is limited to a maximum of six (6) tables and/or figures and/or graphs that complement the variety of information intended for the readers to understand.*

CLOSING

It contains a conclusion written in very clear words that directly refer to the research objectives and answers the research problems, without repeating the discussion. REFERENCES

All references must be in APA 7th Edition style using reference management software or applications like Mendeley and presented within the main body of the article. The author may also include a list of further readings and additional references, websites, eBooks, etc., within the main body of the article. All final references must be mentioned in the article in the form of in-text citations. *The references for Jurnal Netnografi Komunikasi (JNK) should use Gadugi font, size 11pt, and single line spacing. References must include at least 15 sources, with 80% of them cited from scholarly journal articles published within the last ten (10) years.*

The reference list must be arranged in alphabetical order based on the last name of the first author of each work.
