If you think you found any mistakes, please DM me in discord.



## 1. Covered regions


Qatar had very limited coverage when I was making this document. You could only find official coverage in only seven different spots across the country. In this chapter I will briefly go over every spot. I kept this in the document even though there is now way more coverage, because it gives you a slightly better understanding of parts of the country.



## 1.1. Al Bayt

Official Qatar coverage was released during the football world cup in 2022. To promote this, the Google street view car drove mostly around the stadiums or other landmarks. These buildings are very easy to spot and are useful for pinpointing your location.

The first building I will talk about is located in the city of Al Bayt in Al Khor and Al Daayen regions in northern Qatar.


The big green square in the middle is the Al Bayt Stadium Park. Here you can find the Al Bayt Stadium. It looks like a giant tent with horizontal stripes. Use the proximity to the tent and your compass to estimate your location.

1.2. Lusail

The city of Lusail is the second spot with coverage and is located just above Doha. Recognizing this place is very easy because you can see the four giant Lusail Plaza towers.

It is also possible to find the Lusail Stadium in the west of the city. It looks like a giant basket. This stadium is way harder to see than the towers.

1.3. Education City

The place with the most coverage is probably Education City. Here you can find multiple parks and a couple of distinct landmarks.

The Longines Arena is not visible from far away, so you will not see it very often. Outside the arena you can see a few horse statues, because there are tournaments being held here for riding horses.

The Education City Stadium looks like a giant gray donut with a diamond-shaped texture. You will see this stadium very often.

#### 1.4. Rawdat Al Jahhaniya

This city is found west of Education City. It features the Ahmed Bin Ali stadium. It is distinct by its roof.





### 1.5. Khalifa International

South of Education City, another big spot with coverage is located. In the Aspire Park in Ar-Rayyan, you can find a couple of distinct landmarks.


The Khalifa International Stadium is not too visible. Using the Torch Tower to estimate your guess is way better.

## 1.6. Hamad International Airport

In the very east of Doha, you can find some official trekker coverage. The entire Hamad International Airport is covered. This can be difficult to 25k, but fortunately, you will almost never get these locations.

1.7. Museum of Islamic Art

The last location where you can find Google coverage is in the Museum of Islamic Art, in the north of Doha. Just like the airport, you will almost never be here.

## 2. Parkings

You can find many parkings all around the country. If you want a perfect score, being able to recognize every parking is very useful, because you need to be extremely close to get 5000 points in Qatar.

### 2.1. Al Bayt Parkings

In the Al Bayt region, there are four big parkings outside the Al Bayt park.

The four big parkings (Parking 54, Parking B and Parking C) look somewhat similar. A quick way to tell which one you are on, is to look at the stadium. On P54, the stadium is very far and to your east. On PC, the stadium is in your north, and on PB, the stadium is in your northeast. On P7, you are very close to the stadium. But knowing which parking is not enough, since you need to be in a 25 meter radius of the location.

**Pinpointing Parking 54:** Not the entire parking is covered. I highlighted the coverage lines in different colors and provided hints to make a better estimated guess.



**Red:** You are on the edge of the parking, try to pinpoint using the compass and distance to the northern and southern edges.

**Purple:** You are on the edge of the parking with a unique road angle. Look how close you are to the northern edge and the bend.

**Green:** You are not on the edge of the parking but with a unique road angle.

**Dark blue:** You see tents (T) very close east of you.

**Yellow:** You see white outer lines. Look at the lamps (.) and the intersection between the light green and light blue line to guess. If you are in the northern part, guess between the two yellow lines.

**Light blue:** The lamps to your west are very close to you. Look at the lamps from the image and the intersection to estimate where you are.


**Gray:** The lamps to your west are a bit further. Look at the lamps from the image and the intersection to estimate where you are. Guess between the two lines.

**Orange:** You are on a road south of the parking. The stadium is in the east. Try to look at the parking to see how far you are from the edges or the middle.

**Pinpointing Parking C:** You have to zoom in a lot on parking C to see it. Also, only the upper two are covered. This parking is harder to get a perfect score on, because you could be anywhere on the two parkings, and the shape of the parking is just a rectangle. Therefore it is better to look at some vehicles and objects on the parking. In the official Qatar map, you can only be on the edges.



Gray rectangle: There are some iron bars on the ground near the top left entrance.

Green dashes: There is a gate in the fence.

Blue rectangle: There is a blue crane on the side of the parking. This is easily the most distinct feature of the parking.

Blue oval: There are two container tanks on the second parking.

Black lines: There are three black lines with dust on the ground. The black is not visible from far away. (This image does not show the dust great.)

Yellow gear: Some men with yellow vests gathered in a circle. They are picking up trash.

Brown square: There is a crate on the ground.


White oval: There are some tents in the bottom-right corner. This is the only place on the parking where the Google car does not drive. Do not confuse this with the tents of a different parking.



You can also see a white bus and a red truck, but since they are moving, they are not useful.

**Pinpointing Parking B:** This parking southeast of the stadium is one of the largest of the country. You can divide the parking in six parts. As shown on the image below, I will be referring to them as numbers from one to six.



- You can tell apart parts 4, 5 and 6 from the others, because they have **open lamps**. Open lamps on the **edges** are a little different. The tops of **closed lamps** look like sprinklers.

Beige rectangle: This is the best way to tell what part you are on. In the upper left corner of the second part, there is a building with bridge and a staircase that can be seen from anywhere on the parking.

Purple squares: Just like on Parking C, there are concrete blocks on the parking. They are located in the middle of every part, except for the second, where an almost similar looking one was placed in the corner next to the building.

Light gray dashes: These are stone walls to indicate where you cannot drive. These are almost everywhere, but they can be useful to estimate where you are based how close you are to them.

White dashes: In the top of the first part, there are some white fences visible.

Red dashes: Next to the fences, some men are placing alternating red and white walls.

Light gray oval: Three men with a white truck are repairing a broken lamp. After some time, they are done, and they drive away. This means they are not always visible.

Orange square: There is an orange machine hiding behind a wall.

Black line: Just like on parking C, there are black lines on the ground. One stretches all the way from part one to part three, and the other is found on only part 2. Important to know is that there is no line in parts four, five and six.

White oval: Just like on the other parkings, there are white tents.

Red circles: Next to the tents, and somewhere on part 5, many red and white walls are being stored.

Gray line: On part six, there is some construction going on. Sometimes you can see a lot of water and a truck, but sometimes the truck is already gone and the water dried up. But one thing that is always there, is an iron tube.

Orange circle: From some parts of the parking, you can see an orange crane next to the tube. The crane is not always there.

Remember that there are more things you can see than I described, but since they are moving or only visible in a few locations, I let them out.

**Pinpointing Parking 7:** This should not be too hard to learn, due to the limited coverage on this parking. Counting from top to bottom, only the **fourth** “horizontal” line is entirely covered, and counting from left to right, you can only be on the **first, second, fifth or sixth** “vertical” line.



Red dashes: There are alternating red and white walls.

To know where you are on the “vertical” lines, look how many lamps (.) you are away from the red and white walls.



## 2.2. Lusail Parkings

There are only two parkings in the covered region of Lusail. I will call them the left parking and the right parking, since the right parking does not have a name. You can easily tell that you are in Lusail by seeing the four towers.

**Pinpointing the left parking:** since this parking is so small, looking at the distance to the edges should be enough. To know you are not on the other parking, you can look at two clues.



Red and white rectangle: There is a mess of walls on the left side of the parking. Looking which way you are facing could narrow down your guess even further.

Purple circle: You can find three purple concrete blocks next to each other.

White rectangles: You can also find some tents here. The tents are different from the tents in Al Bayt, because they are surrounded by light blue and purple World Cup advertisements. The tents form an L-shape.

Brown square: In the bottom-right corner, a weird wooden box can be seen.

Beige rectangle: This building is very close to the parking. It can be used to orient quickly.

### 2.3. Education City Parkings

Education City contains twenty covered parkings. That might sound like a lot, but fortunately, almost every parking is super small. Being able to recognize every parking and knowing where they are is the most important thing to learn here.

I made a map where you can find all the locations of the parkings. I gave them numbers that correspond with this document. Remember that I made the numbers up, they are not their real names.



**Recognizing parking 1:** This parking is recognizable by the beige square-shaped tents. Since this parking is not too big, you do not need to be very accurate.


Remember to guess **between** the horizontal lines, because that is where the Google car actually drove.

- On the left side of the parking, there are a lot of cars, and on the right side only a few.
- You can see two radio towers (\*\*) in the bottom-right corner. This can help to orient quickly.

**Pinpointing parking 2:** This is definitely the largest parking of the city. There is also a lot of construction going on here. The clues I provided should be enough if you look at the crossroads, edges, etc.



White rectangle: There is a truck in the left section, and two near the entrance on the right. The lone one is parked next to a row of fences and is also your best clue for the left part.

Black dots: There are only four lamps on the entire parking. This makes pinpointing easier.

Orange circle: Just below the left section, you can see a lot of vehicles behind some fences. One of them is an orange bulldozer.

Yellow circle: Another vehicle is a yellow excavator. This one is best visible from the vertical lines just east to it.

White circle: Just south of the excavator, you can find a normal white car.

Dark gray rectangle: Here you can find a lot of storage for construction materials like fences. Depending on how far north it is to you, you can differentiate the two horizontal roads in the center.

Blue circle: You can easily recognize the lower section in the right when you see these light blue barrels.

Light gray square: There is a tent here with a distinct blocky pattern on it. There are also other tents and buildings to the east of it.

**Recognizing parking 3:** This parking in the north of the city has also tents to protect cars against the sun. They are different from the ones in the first parking, because they are lower near the pole.


**Pinpointing parking 3:** Just like parking one, this is a relatively small parking. Looking at the edges and counting the rows should be enough. One additional hint is that here, there are many cars parked on the right side, and only two cars in the bottom-left. The rest of the parking is empty.

**Recognizing parking 4:** This parking has no tents and is easy to recognize by a blue and green container.



**Pinpointing parking 4:** Only the upper half of this parking is covered. This makes it so that if you guess in the middle of the covered area, you are almost always guaranteed a perfect score. If you want to be sure, you can look at the distance to the road or the containers, who are placed where the coverage ends.



**Recognizing parking 5:** This parking has a lot of gutters and parking islands. You can also see a cubic building with square holes in it to your east.



Yellow line: You can recognize the western part if you see these yellow and gray advertisements.

Yellow oval: There is only one yellow car on the parking and it is pretty distinct.

- The parking islands resemble the blue coverage lines very well, but remember you can be above the most northern line as well.

**Recognizing parking 6:** The cubic building with holes is here in your north. Additionally, the lines on the ground to indicate parking space are faded, so you will not see them very well.

**Pinpointing parking 6:** This one may require a little bit of practice, but fortunately it is a small parking. Here, it is very important to look at the edges of the parking.



Thick green line: You can see palm trees here. This helps to know instantly which side is which, because at the other side, you can only see regular trees.





**Green circle:** There is a statue of a giant football hiding in the trees on the left side. It can be very difficult to see. If you do see it, you can use it for pinpointing, as it marks the top-left covered corner very well. (Pro tip: You can also recognize the road next to the parking by looking for this ball.)





**Recognizing parking 7:** It is easy to recognize this parking because you can see the HBKU (Hamad Bin Khalifa University) to your east. From the parking itself, you can know you are looking at this building because of this unique poster. Some locations are easy to locate because of the DNA from the poster on the left.

**Pinpointing parking 7:** It may not look like there is any coverage on this parking when you look at the image below, but there is because the covered lines and the actual locations do not always line up exactly. For example, the most southern horizontal line should actually be slightly higher.




Because you cannot be in the middle of the parking, you only need to look at the closest wall and guess there. Depending on how far the university or the other walls are, you can easily get a perfect score. The locations have a relatively big offset from the coverage lines though, but you should be fine.

**Recognizing parking 8:** This parking is easy to recognize because you can see the Qatar Foundation Mosque. It has a very distinct pattern.

**Pinpointing parking 8:** This parking has limited coverage, but there is actually coverage between the central covered horizontal line and the uncovered one underneath.



White rectangle: The reason the coverage ends in the west is again because of tents. This makes some locations easier to pinpoint.

Blue circle: The best clues on the parking are the vehicles. There are three of them that parked away from the rest. You can see a white bus with blue buildings from this area in Education City on it. Remember that the two sides of the bus have different things on them, so just look at the colors.

Red circle: A bit to the east of the bus, there is a lone white car.

**Recognizing parking 9:** Apart from being next to the Longines Arena, you can recognize this huge parking by these distinct cubic trees and tents to protect cars from the sun in the south. Try not to confuse the tents with those from other parkings.

**Pinpointing parking 9:** This is a very large parking, but you can easily narrow your location down to one of the three covered lines. If the square trees are to your south (Away from arena), you are on the upper line. The ground is also covered with smaller tiles here. If the trees are to your north and there is a fair distance between you and the tents, you are on the middle line. And if you are very close to the tents, you are on the bottom line. A good way to increase your chance of getting a perfect score, is guessing slightly above the line you are on.



Green dashes: These are the best clues on this parking. You can see three ways to cross the parking on foot, indicated by double rows of small bushes with rocks. Since there are three of them, you can easily figure out where you are by looking how many of them are to your west or east. This clue works best on the lower two covered lines.

Gray dashes: On the upper covered line, where the bushes with rocks end, you can see a difference in the tiles on the ground. The small dark tiles are replaced with lighter, bigger tiles.

Green circle: You can see a big tree peeking out of the arena. This is useful for pinpointing on the upper covered line.





Brown circle: Close to the tree, you can see some statues of horses.





Yellow circle: When looking to the middle entrance with bushes and rocks, you can see one man sitting on a chair. If you are on the upper line, you will also see a lot of other people. The man on the chair is the only one visible from the other lines.

Blue circle: Also next to the second entrance, you can see a dark blue car underneath a tent.

**Recognizing parking 10:** Moving back to the bottom-left of the city, you can find the tenth parking in the golfing area. This area is distinct by a bollard.





**Pinpointing parking 10:** This is a complicated parking and may look confusing at first, because there are not a lot of distinct objects or vehicles on it. That is why I divided the parking by its roads. The Street View coverage map is messed up.



**Red:** This is the most southern road. On your west you can see brown soil and big rocks. Pinpointing here might look like a challenge, but it is possible if you look at the entrance to the parking. Opposite of this entrance, on the highway next to it, is a big metal sign. Very important to know about this road is that it continues in the west, outside of the covered area. Guessing slightly above the road is also a good idea.

Gray: While the map says there is coverage, you actually cannot be here. One exception is the intersection with the two most northern horizontal lines.

Light green: This section of the parking is recognizable by these two cars in the bottom-right corner. Guess in the middle of the green road and the line above it.





**Dark blue:** You are on the outer road of the parking. Look at the road angle. On the very north of this road, you can find a building with golf carts outside. This is the Education City Golf Club.

**Yellow:** On this section of the parking, you are just south of the tents, and right above the section with the two cars (You are to the west of the entrance). Guess a bit higher than the yellow line.





**Purple:** You are also just south of the tents, but here you are to the east of the entrance.

**!Exception:** Although the map does not show it, you can be in the section south of the purple road. You can recognize this because you are next to the most southern road and the cars are not in this section.



**Recognizing parking 11:** Now I will show you the extremely small parkings. This parking of the City is located next to the Premier Inn Hotel. There are tents and they are low with slightly round roofs.

**Pinpointing parking 11:** Just guessing on it is almost always enough, and if you look at the edges and the hotel, you should easily get a perfect score. (If you are really close to the hotel, guess on the southern road, if there are tents between you and the hotel, guess on the northern road.) Guess slightly higher than the roads.




**Recognizing parking 12:** This is just some parking space around the Central Plant 4 building (CP4)

**Pinpointing parking 12:** You can only be north, east or west of the building. Since the road in the north is a bit longer, I provided one clue. Looking at the edges and the building should be enough.




G4S: There are two white cars next to each other with the logo G4S on it.

**Pinpointing parking 13:** This one is actually quite hard. For some reason, there is just one line of coverage on a giant parking, and there are not a lot of clues. You can see the Education City stadium directly in your west.



Red rectangles: You can see small red and white buildings with “Budweiser” on it. The image below was taken from the most southern point of the road.

Black lines: There are some black lines on the ground, and you can use the intersection for pinpointing. Notice that the actual location is slightly more to the left of the road. You almost drive through the intersection.

**Recognizing parking 14:** This is actually not just one parking, but three. I gave them numbers. You can see that 1 and 3 look like each other, but 2 has darker and smaller tiles on the ground.



**Pinpointing parking 14:** You might think this is hard because there are three of them at once, but you can actually only find parking spaces on the eastern vertical roads. The best clue is the distance to the edges.



Recognizing parking 15: This absolutely tiny parking next to the Al Rayyan Police Station is easy to recognize by the distinct fences. Because it is so small, I marked a place you should always guess if you are here with a red circle. It will guarantee a perfect score.

**Recognizing parking 16:** This is again actually not one parking, it is two of them. You have a vertical road north of the Multaqa Student Center building, and a curve south of the building.



**Pinpointing parking 16:** The southern curve is easy to pinpoint because you can look at the road angle. The ground is covered in small dark tiles.

The road in the north is slightly harder. Look at the building because it has an interesting shape that also appears on the map.

Yellow line: This line represents the tents south of the northern road. The important thing to notice is where it ends on the right side. The image I used in the recognizing section above is taken from that location.

Black lines: You can see black windows on these buildings. You can also see them on the southern side of the building.

**Pinpointing parking 17:** This next “parking” is located next to parking 4. There are just some parking spaces with beige tents around a building.



Yellow lines: These lines resemble the tents. The only roads with both coverage and tents is the road south of the building, and the one east of it.

**Recognizing parking 18:** This road full of parking spots without tents is next to the Qatar Academy Senior School. You cannot see it well however, because there is a metro stop in between.

**Pinpointing parking 18:** It is just a road, so you can look at the intersections, edges, and the metro station. This should be very doable.




The parking is the second most southern covered road on the image.

**Pinpointing parking 19:** This parking is extremely small. Recognizing it and knowing where it is, is the most important part.

Pinpointing parking 20: We are back where we started in the city. This parking is next to the first one. It is very small, so pinpointing it is easy. You can recognize it by the same tents as parking one, and a red bus on the side.

Black x: In the most northern corner of the parking, you can find a unique small pole with cameras on it. It also has a small box. This is very useful to pinpoint the northern roads.

Gray oval: You can see a big truck here. It is white with a blue horizontal stripe on it.

Black squares: These are the only two lamps on the covered region. They were just placed, so you can see that they are standing in a black concrete square. There is also a line from the poles to the southern road. The line by the western pole is way darker than the one by the eastern pole.



If the road angle is north to south, you can look at which way the car faces to make an even better guess. Always guess **between** two vertical lines. You can search for the central horizontal line (where the white lines on the ground stop for a moment) to calculate your latitude.



Section one is just to the right of the first vertical line that has an intersection with the central horizontal line. Section nineteen is the last section. While playing, you can start counting from either side. The sections continue north of the central horizontal line.

Section one is the only one to have a blurred car, except for the most southern part of the line between sections one and two. Here, the car faces south. In the list below, this is marked with \*.

Section eleven has no coverage, except in the very south, where it faces north and almost crashed in a pile of sand. I marked it as no coverage.

Between sections 16 and 17, the road is actually covered in the right place. I marked this with 16.5.

**Pinpointing Qatar Mall parkings:** In the middle of Rawdat Al Jahhaniya, the Mall of Qatar is located. This is the biggest shopping center of the country. It has a distinct pattern and a yellowish color. One section of the mall, KidzMondo, has a very distinct blue color. There are parkings all around this mall.




As you can see on the image above, you can either be on a parking west, south or east of the mall.

## Western parking


**How to know which row you are on:** All around this parking, you can see red signs with letters on them. They start at A and end at X. If you want to know what row you are on, you need to understand the somewhat complicated system behind the signs. On the image below, you can see the covered roads where the car can drive. The letters do not correspond with these roads, but with double parking places between them. I will go deeper into this.



On the following image, you can see a zoomed-in version of the upper section of this parking. I added the places where you can park in different colors. The letters on the red signs indicate a different colored line (double parking spaces) (A = red, B = orange, ...). You can now clearly see that if you drive somewhere on the parking, you will see a sign to your left, and one to your right.


You are somewhere on a parking and the mall is in your west. When you look east to the signs, you see B in your north, and C in your south. This means that you are between the orange and yellow line. You now know what road you are on. You can also see that you are not too far away from the western exit, so you can make an even better guess. (You should also guess slightly higher than the road here because the locations are not exactly in place again.)

I said in the example that you looked east for the signs, but they are also in the west. This means you can almost always see at least one sign.

Some bad news is that a couple of signs in the east are not placed yet. The missing signs are: E, F, M, N, O. Here, you just have to look at where the KidzMondo is, or at neighboring rows.

You might think there are some missing signs in the west as well, but they are just replaced with black and purple recto verso flags. If you see a letter on them, and you are looking to the south, then you know what line the flag represents. If you see a letter on them and you are looking north, you need to count one down (Ex. E --> D). This may sound tricky, but after some practice you will surely understand the system way better.

There is even more confusion. When you are counting past M, you need to know something very important. There is a fountain and palm trees where the southern part of O and the northern part of P were supposed to be. This means you have to count both O and P here to get to Q. The fountain and palms basically are O and P combined.



Three more things:

- The recto verso flags in the west reset at some point. I have no idea why this is. Luckily, the purple part turns red after the reset. Keep in mind not to look at the red flags, as they do not make sense.
- On the Google map where you can make a guess, there is a label called Ahmad Bin Ali Spectator Parking E. This is the real name of the entire parking, not row E. It is actually located between F and G.
- There is an extra single line of parking after X. You cannot be there up close, but this can be a bit confusing as there is no Y sign.

### Southern parking

This parking consists of two roundabouts, two long roads, three vertical parking spaces, and one road to the side.



You can easily recognize and tell apart the two roundabouts. They both have an interesting statue of them, but only the eastern roundabout is south of the Al Rayyan Hotel. The western roundabout is also way smaller.

You can easily pinpoint the upper road. The only useful hint I can give here is that you are in front of the entrance of the MOQ when you are in the big dip in the road.

The lower road is harder to pinpoint, but you can make use of the same system as the western parking. You need to look for yellow signs with letters on them. You can also use this for the upper road and the three vertical roads in the middle.




The road on the side in the southeast is distinct by its gray tents. You can pinpoint by looking at the yellow signs with letters.

## Eastern parking

For most of the locations here, you can use the letters system. The signs are green here.

Unfortunately, a big section of the parking is before the A, and does not have letters. The letters go from south to north here. I think that the letters stop being useful at M, because N, O, P and Q are missing again, and after a while it continues with R to U, but the coverage ends at T. U does not exist on the map.



Pinpointing the section where N, O, P and Q are missing is slightly harder. You first need to know what Magnolia Bakery and Wooden Bakery are.

Magnolia Bakery is one of the more famous shops of the mall. When you look on the map where you can make a guess, it is one of the labels that shows up in the right place. Wooden Bakery is next to it. If you can see the mall well enough, look for these bakeries.




Magnolia Bakery (Left) and Wooden Bakery (Right)

From the parking itself, you cannot always see the mall up close. Always try to find the bakeries. I recommend looking for Wooden Bakery, because it uses distinct white letters on a black background.

If you cannot see one of the bakeries, you can probably see a letter again. And if that is also not the case, you should look where the homes R us is. The mall is deeper here, and the map shows that.

The bottom section of the parking is harder to pinpoint, as there are no signs with letters. I have gathered some clues to orient better in this section.



Gear: There is a man working on a part of the parking. You can see him from far away. Next to him is a small grass hill.

White rectangle: There is a very easy to see Mitsubishi truck on the parking. Eventually, the truck moves, but stays around this area. This is a very good clue. You can easily remember where the truck is located on the map, because there already is a gray rectangle on it. Always try to look for the truck.

Blue circle: There are two men standing close to the truck. They are useful to pinpoint, as they are standing on the only vertical road.

Yellow triangle: A good way to pinpoint the eastern road is to look at the ground. You can find a lot of clues here like roads to the side. You can also see small yellow triangles somewhere. They are next to the most southern exit, which makes it a good clue from far away.

Brown circles: There are only two palm trees around this section. This is a very useful clue.

Ones and twos: If you look closely to the intersection of the eastern road and the horizontal parking roads, you will either see a single or a double line. These alternate, and you can even see a triangle on the ground if the line is double. If a line is single in the east, it is double in the west, and vice versa.

Green line with A: This is of course parking row A, but it also features a long thin line of hedges.


## 2.5. Khalifa International Parkings

There are a lot of large parkings in this region of the country. Some are located inside Aspire park, some are outside of it.

I made a map again where you can find all the locations of the parkings. I gave them numbers that correspond with this document. Remember that I made the numbers up, they are not their real names.



**Recognizing parking 1:** This parking is recognizable because the Torch tower and Khalifa International Stadium can be seen directly south.

**Pinpointing parking 1:** There is not a lot to say about this parking, because it is one of the smallest in the city. Looking closely at the edges, the bend in the road next to the parking and the exits should be enough. The most important part should just be knowing where it is located.




**Recognizing parking 2:** This parking is located right next to a building called Iconic 2022. You can easily recognize this building, because it is shaped like 2022. You can see it in your west. The parking itself is very dense at has curved tents above the parking spaces.

**Pinpointing parking 2:**



Black dashes: There is a pedestrian crossing running across the entire parking in the middle from north to south. This is the best clue of the parking, because you can narrow down your guess to only one side.

Numbers (0, 1 or 2): Just like the parkings next to the mall, you have a couple of options for the amount of lines for each entrance. You can have one, two or none. There is always a triangle next to double lines. You can use this clue from anywhere on the parking. The pattern is easy to memorize, because the bottom numbers coincidentally spell 2022.

**Recognizing parking 3:** You can easily recognize this double parking by very small yellow with black walls.




Yellow with black walls

**Pinpointing parking 3:** Again, not a lot to talk about here, just look closely at the edges. A good way to distinguish the left part from the right part is the gap between the walls. This is the entrance of the vertical road between the two sides.

Brown rectangle: There are some small houses with a distinct pattern on the bottom left.

**Recognizing parking 4:** This parking has a clean feel to it, because it is so spacious and surrounded by grass. It is a big parking. You can also see blue tents, and most important of all, the Aspire Zone Foundation Headquarter (AZFHQ).

**Pinpointing parking 4:** You can divide the parking in two parts: the upper and the lower part.



Orange rectangle: One of the best clue for pinpointing is the AZFHQ, as seen in the image earlier. This is a very recognizable building and can also be seen from other parkings. Use this building to estimate a better guess.

Dark blue lines: In front of the AZFHQ, there is a section with blue tents to protect your car from the sun. Pinpointing might seem difficult here, but you can use a handy trick. You can see on the image below that you have double tents (D) and half tents (H). They are symmetrically placed. (HDDDDH)

When you get a location inside of these tents, look at the AZFHQ. If you are in front of the entrance, you can guess between the two central dark blue lines. If you are slightly to the left or right of the entrance, move one dark blue line to the left or right respectively. If you are directly looking at one of the beige walls with text, move one line further once again. There are also rows of tents with only half the length of a normal one. You can label these on the map quickly, because you can see a rectangle of roads on both sides.

Black line: This road splits the two sections of the parking. There is not actually a black line, but it is a good clue to look for. The road seems darker, and you can see the intersection with the road next to the parking.

Light gray dashes: There is something strange on the Google map. You can see on the map that north of the upper part, there is a small extra parking. However, this is not the case because the map is inaccurate. The parking should continue on, even outside of the image I provided. Luckily, not the entire parking is covered, only the region inside of the gray dashes (the entire dashed lines are also covered). The only locations outside of the image are some sides of the parking. You can recognize the fake corner if you see this exit right in front of you, and you are parallel with the ends of the blue tents.





**Recognizing parking 5:** This parking is very large. You can easily recognize it because there are a lot of big wooden fences here.




Big wooden fences

**Pinpointing parking 5:** This is easily one of the most difficult parkings to get a perfect score on, but there are some useful clues.

**Yellow rectangle:** In the top-right corner, you can see a house and a yellow vehicle.

Black circle: You can find a Nissan and a truck here, but the best clue of this area is the puddle of water on the ground.

Beige rectangle: You can see a different truck here. You can also find a strange beige construction outside of the parking here.

Red rectangles: Here, two white with red buses are parked. These indicate the upper-left exit.

Gray rectangle: Here you can find yet another truck. This one is a bit more distinct than the others.

Black dotted lines: Almost every car is parked on the right side of the parking. A big portion of the vehicles are small black buses. A lot of them are parked next to each other. There are also a few cars between the row of buses. This is the gap in the dotted line.


Black line: This is probably the only time you will use bird-meta. You can see one in the distance here. If you think you might be here, look very close to your west, north and east, as the bird can be far away at some points.



**Recognizing parking 6:** Entering the Aspire park, this tiny parking is recognizable by its blue tents and the Aspire Basketball Court (ABC) in the southwest.

**Pinpointing parking 6:** This is very easy to do, because the parking is tiny and not fully covered. You can divide the parking in four roads: the upper one, the middle one, the left one and the right one.



The middle one is so short that you will almost certainly get a perfect score if you guess correctly, but you should still look at the edges to make a better guess. You can recognize this road because it is the only one with tents to both your left and right.

The left one is next to the ABC, and you can further pinpoint by looking for a green sign with “Assembly point” on it. The dark pedestal underneath is better visible than the sign from far away.

The right road is distinct because the road next to it is red. Look at the entrance to the middle road.

The upper road can be recognized by the thick clean green line of grass next to it. Look for a barrier on the road. The Google car actually drives through it.

The road connecting the upper and right roads is very easy to recognize, because you can see the Hand Ring holding Earth statue here. This is also labeled on the map.





**Recognizing parking 7:** This is just a part of a huge parking, but luckily, only a small portion is covered. There are beige tents again, and the Google car drove here while it was golden hour.




Beige tents and golden hour

**Pinpointing parking 7:** Since there are no apparent objects on the parking, the best way to pinpoint is by looking at the most distinct car around you. Most of them are very easy to spot quickly, some are not.




Before I get into the cars, you should notice the thick light gray lines on the image above. These lines are paths you can cross as a pedestrian. This is a very good clue.

Every circle with a letter or another circle in it is a car. The color of the circle is the same as the color of the car.

Red circle, black G: You can see a red GAC parked at the end of the lowest parking row.



Black circle, white S: Someone with a black Suzuki parked their car at the end of the third lowest row and forgot to close the door.




Red circle, black V: You can see a red Volkswagen at the end of row 4.



Red circle, black smaller circle: Here you can see a dark red 4x4 with a big spare tire. You cannot really see the brand of this car.



Red circle, black M: Here you can find a red Mitsubishi. It also has a spare tire, but it has a red cover on it.



White circle, black T: There is a white Toyota here with a horizontal line across it.



Black circle, white R: You can see a big RAM here.



White circle, black N: You can find a white Nissan here.



White circle, black smaller circle: You can find a big white car here with a spare tire. It has a unique cover.



Black circle, red G: You can see a black GMC truck here.



Black circle, white M: The only car parked in this section is a black Mercedes.



Dark blue circle, red G: There is another GMC here, but this one is dark blue, not black.



Red circle, white M: You can find another Mitsubishi Pajero here. They are the exact same model. You can tell them apart because this one is next to the road in the north. Also, the word Pajero is easier to read here.



White rectangle: There is a singular white tent at the end of the second lowest row.

Red rectangles: You can find white buses with red stripes all over this parking, but there is one spot with clearly the most of them.

**Recognizing parking 8:** This parking is actually a part of the huge parking the previous one also was. The time is now just after golden hour, and the Khalifa International Stadium (KIS) is in your north.

**Pinpointing parking 8:** There are many football-related statues here. They are nation flags shaped like balls. There is also a statue of the world cup itself.





Orange circle: You can see an orange crane here. This marks the leftmost exit.





**Recognizing parking 11:** This parking is super small. You can see this very beautiful building in your south.





**Pinpointing parking 11:** Because this parking is so small, you can always guess on the red circle from the image below for a guaranteed perfect score, unless you are very close to the road in the north (Not on image). The blue coverage lines are strange and the southern part is even fake.



**Villaggio Mall Parkings:** In the south of the Aspire Zone, you will find the Villaggio Mall. There are parkings all around it, but not all of them are covered. You can be in the west, northwest, or the east. Just look at the mall to see on which of the three you are on.

**Pinpointing the western parking:** This section on its own is already pretty big. Fortunately, there are a lot of clues here.



I will first mention three shops:

Yellow L: This pastry shop from Paris has yellow walls and spells Ladurée with big letters. You can easily recognize it.

Green M&S: This shop called Marks & Spencer is visible from very far away.

Dark blue C: There is a Carrefour here. Do not mistake this one with the one in the MOQ.

Red line: this is the only road here that is reddish. You can see a big difference when you see the two types of concrete next to each other.


Dark blue lines: You can see quite a few shopping carts on this parking. Most of them are very south, but there are also some next to the red road.

**Pinpointing the northwestern parking:** This section is actually very easy if you know where you can be. There is a spacious parking lot in the north, a roundabout, a road above the roundabout, and a section next to Ladurée. There is also a road in the south between some shops of the mall. You can pinpoint by looking at the colors of the shops because I marked them on the map.

The parking just north of Ladurée is in the shape of a right triangle. This makes pinpointing doable without even having to see this location even once, but I still recommend playing the practice map here.

**Pinpointing the eastern parking:** This one is pretty big, but there are a lot of clues. The best thing to learn here is where the coverage is.

Dark gray circle + line: This is the torch tower, the highest building of the country. You can see it from almost anywhere in the city. Use the tower to orient better. The dark gray line represents a bridge from the mall to the tower.
