The University of Minnesota (UMN) is a non-traditional MS4; permit items 20.10 through 20.16 do not apply.

- Permit item 20.10: The UMN owns large contiguous land areas and does not have platted "right of way"
- Permit item 20.11, 20.12, 20.13, 20.14: The UMN owns large contiguous land areas and does not allow "off-site" treatment
 - Note: The definition of "off-site" is considered to be off the site of the contiguous land area. All areas within a contiguous land area are considered on-site.
- Permit item 20.15, 20.16: The University owns all structural stormwater BMPs on University property
