Reviewed proposal from Dr. Aleman for curriculum development for Nature Studies for Virtual and Middle School and Spanish for the Virtual Upper Grades (4th-8th).

- There is not a need for 9 blocks of lesson plans in Nature Studies for grades 5th-8th. Often the courses are taught by CWES. We just need the development of supplemental lessons for when the Practicum students are not available.
- The home activities proposed could be utilized as home projects for TRCMS and additional projects for TRVCS.

The Executive Committee has approved \$1,000 of funding from the Middle School Grant Funds round 2, to support the development of a Nature Studies Curriculum for 5th-8th grade. This curriculum will be utilized by TRCMS faculty when CWES Practicum students are not available to teach. To be consistent with other faculty that is developing curriculum during the summer of 2019, these funds will be distributed by the District once an extended contract is signed by Dr. Aleman and curriculum will be shared with board once completed prior to the 2019/2020 school year.

The Executive Committee has approved \$500 from the 501c3 account for curriculum development for a Spanish Curriculum that will be utilized by Dr. Aleman for 4th-8th grades in the TRVCS Program. These funds will be distributed when the curriculum is shared with the TRCCS board and approved.
