Hello,

I am writing to you as the Chair of the Holy Trinity Parent Council.

As the school year comes to a close, I would like to thank you for the donations you have made throughout the year and the help you provided in raising money towards our parent council initiatives.

This year, we chose to raise money by adding a donation request to School Cash online raising close to \$1200, and by having a fun paint night on December 5th run by two of the parent council members which raised \$961.50. Participants were led through an instructional evening of painting leading to (we hope) an end result of a winter landscape.

With the money raised, we were able to supply two \$500 bursaries to two of our graduating students. These will be presented at this year's graduation ceremony.

A donation of \$250 was also given to the Christmas Caring Collection.

We also, with the help of donations and participation from Pat at Cordick's Country Maples, provided the grade 7 and 8 classes with a pancake breakfast. This happened on February 17th – Shrove Tuesday.

We used our PIC (Parent Involvement Committee) fund this year, to host a fun Trivia night for parents and guardians of Holy Trinity students, which took place on February 13th. This was organized and run by another parent council member. This was a free event for parents/guardians to socialize with each other and was held at The Three Brewers with appetizers, prizes and trivia provided.

We also took the opportunity to collaborate with the All Saints Highschool Parent Council to apply for a PRO (Parent Reaching Out) grant. With this grant we were able to present Christine Clark. Christine spoke to parents and guardians from both schools about her lived experience with Human trafficking, what to watch for, and resources available. It was a very interesting presentation.

None of these initiatives would have been possible without the dedication of our council volunteers, the generosity of our donors, and the collaboration of our teachers and staff. Thank you to everyone.
