POWERSCHOOL / PARENT PORTAL

PowerSchool provides parents and students access to information such as attendance, grades, transportation. Parents are required to complete an application for access to this account. PARENT CANVAS ACCOUNT

Canvas is a learning management system. Parents can create an account in Canvas to monitor their child's progress. To do this, the student must generate a pairing code for the parent to use when creating an account.
