Excel data analysis was utilized for two-tailed dependent t-test analysis. Significant improvements in pretest/posttest SESA measures included the willingness to participate in non- preferred activities 3.05 to 3.35 (p = .01); peer-appropriate communications 3.07 to 3.35 (p=.01); positive peer interactions 3.17 to 3.43 (p = .01); empathy 2.88 to 3.30 (p< .001); appropriate assertiveness 2.70 to 3.05 (p< .001); impulse control 2.67 to 3.33 (p< .001); self-confidence 3.03 to 3.60 (p< .001); pride 3.25 to 3.68 (p< .001); resilience 2.73 to 3.40 (p< .001); ability to endure a stressful environment 2.62 to 3.40 (p< .001); and composite score 29.17 to 34.00 (p< .001)
