Research indicates that teachers need ongoing professional learning to successfully implement HQIM

- Develop instructional goals and questions with the instructional team prior to attending PD
- Consider vacancies, new hires, support staff, instructional leaders, and the budget
- Register using the preferred PD provider for your school/district (Example: Summer 2024 PD)

Systems and Structures for Collaboration

It is **strongly recommended** to allocate grade-level team time before and after each PD for teachers to unpack the unit (assessments, standards, storyline, student supports). Additionally, Common Planning Time or other opportunities to collaborate has been key to success. These **Samula Meeting Avendas** may help with planning in-district PL times. Consider:

- What common planning times are built into the school year and your daily/weekly schedule?
- How will these professional learning times be optimized throughout the year?
